The Basic Stance: Submit - v. 1a

- a) Every Person
- b) To Governing Authorities
- c) Submit (subject to)

3 Reasons

1) God Put Them There - v. 1b

- a) God Orders some "under" others
 - Ps 8:6 creatures under men
 - Ps 46:4 nations under Israel
 - Ps 143:2 people under David
 - Dan 7:7 all under Messiah
- Rom 8:20 creation under curse
- 1 Cor 15:28 Jesus under Father
- Eph 5-6 wives, slaves, children
- Heb 13:17 church under elders
- b) God Establishes & Rules over Rulers
 - Prov 8:15-16
 - Prov 21:1
 - Daniel 4:17,25,32

- Jeremiah 27:5-6
- John 19:11

2) Resistance Brings Vengeance - v. 2

- a) Resistance (3x)
- b) Vengeance
 - By God
 - By Rulers

3) Rulers are God's Servants - v. 3-4

- a) To Approve "Good"
- b) To Avenge "Evil"
