## QUESTION # 142: WHAT ARE THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT? ANSWER:

The sins forbidden in the eighth commandment, besides the neglect of the duties required,<sup>A</sup> are, theft,<sup>B</sup> robbery,<sup>C</sup> man—stealing,<sup>D</sup> and receiving anything that is stolen;<sup>E</sup> fraudulent dealing,<sup>F</sup> false weights and measures,<sup>G</sup> removing land—marks,<sup>H</sup> injustice and unfaithfulness in contracts between man and man,<sup>I</sup> or in matters of trust;<sup>J</sup> oppression,<sup>K</sup> extortion,<sup>L</sup> usury,<sup>M</sup> bribery,<sup>N</sup> vexatious law—suits,<sup>O</sup> unjust inclosures and depopulations;<sup>P</sup> ingrossing commodities to enhance the price;<sup>Q</sup> unlawful callings,<sup>R</sup> and all other unjust or sinful ways of taking or withholding from our neighbour what belongs to him, or of enriching ourselves;<sup>S</sup> covetousness;<sup>T</sup> inordinate prizing and affecting worldly goods;<sup>U</sup> distrustful and distracting cares and studies in getting, keeping, and using them;<sup>V</sup> envying at the prosperity of others;<sup>W</sup> as likewise idleness,<sup>X</sup> prodigality, wasteful gaming; and all other ways whereby we do unduly prejudice our own outward estate,<sup>Y</sup> and defrauding ourselves of the due use and comfort of that estate which God hath given us.<sup>Z</sup>
