Confession of Sin

We, poor sinners confess to you Almighty God and Merciful Father that we have sinned against you and your commandments in many ways.

We confess that we have not believed in you our God and Father, but have put our trust in creatures more than in you our God and Creator, because we have feared them more than you and for their benefit and pleasure we have done and left undone many things in disobedience to you and your commandments.

We confess that we have taken your holy name in vain. We have not always professed it or kept it holy, as we ought, but even more we have slandered it often and grossly with our life, words, and deeds.

We confess that we have not kept your Sabbath holy, that we have not heard your holy word with earnestness, nor lived according to the same. Moreover, we have not yielded ourselves fully to your divine hand nor rejoiced in your work done in us and in others, but have often grumbled against it and have been impatient.

We confess that we have not honored our fathers and mothers, that we have been disobedient to all who we justly owe obedience, such as father and mother, our superiors, and all who have tried to guide and teach us faithfully.

We confess that we have taken life, that we have offended our neighbor often and grossly by word and deed, caused him harm, grown angry over him, borne hatred and envy toward him and deprived him of the honor due him.

R Christ have mercy upon us.

We confess that we have stolen, we acknowledge our greed. We admit that in the use of our worldly goods that we have set ourselves against you and your holy laws. Greedily, and against charity, have we grasped our possessions and scarcely if at all have we given them to those in need.

We confess that we have borne false witness, that we have been untrue and unfaithful toward our neighbors, we have lied to them, we have told lies about them, we have failed to defend their honor and reputation as our own.

We confess that we have coveted the possessions and spouses of others; We acknowledge in summary that our whole life has been filled with sin and transgression against your holy commandments.
