LAODICEA: BE ZEALOUS, PART 3 - Rv 3:19-22

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1. "The American Paradox"; "Affluenza". Love of \$ can -> apostasy - 1T 6:10. <u>Rv 3:14-22</u>

5th: Words of Exhortation - v19b

- 1. Jesus continues to call for repentance, in spite of nausea.
- 2. Jesus urges church to do business w/ Him: buy gold, garment, & eye-salve. How? Repentance & faith in Jesus.
- 3. Jesus loves & seeks cov intimacy calls church be zealous & repent 2 imperatives = obed response to sin of lukewarm, fence-straddling.
 - i. *zealous* root idea is "hot" [v15 *hot* = Eng "zest"].
 - ii. *repent* definitive act [*be zealous* = continuous action]
 - iii. 1Pt 1:22 fervently love from the heart; Jn 21:15ff Do you love Me?

6th: Words of Encouragement - v20

- 1. Behold see Jesus at the door & knock. Houses cld be billeted Jesus knocks to gain admission: personal rlnshp [come into him] & enjoy table fellowship [dine w/ him & he w/ Me].
- 2. Jesus takes the initiative of love. We respond: hear, interp His approach; repent = open door, sit at table & engage in personal fellowship w/ Jesus.
 - i. The church receives Jesus to the extent that each individual member receives Jesus.
 - ii. Jesus is not endorsing a Sardis situation: *a few people* [3:4]. He wants the entire congregation to repent zealously.
- 3. dine = KJV: "sup" '[Lord's Supper Lk 22:20]. Eating & drinking in presence of & w/ deity is a universally basic form of worship.
 - i. <u>1C 10:19-22</u> pagan banquet or Lord's Table? Xn can't eat at both. Note: v22 Jesus is *jealous* same Grk root for *zealous* [Rv 3:19].
 - ii. <u>Rv 19:7-9</u> prepare for the marriage *supper* [our term] of the Lamb
- 4. Jesus' letter is emotionally intense: w/ jealousy calling for zeal [cf 2C 2:4]. Dennis Johnson: cannot ignore Jesus' knock: open or be judged.

7th: Promises to the Overcomers - <u>v21</u>

- 1. He who overcomes living Xn life sanctification, persevering faith
- 2. Jesus' experience shared w/ overcomer: enthronement
 - i. Jesus' resurrection ascension enthronement. Rv 5 [Mk 16:19; Eph 1:20; Heb 1:3; 8:1; 12:2]. Jesus is presently reigning [Amillennial].
- 3. Victorious reign of saints Dan 7:27; 1C 6:2-3; 2T 2:12
 - i. <u>Rv 22:5</u> eternal state described as an everlasting *reign*.
 - ii. <u>Rv 20:4</u> martyred witnesses seated on thrones
- 4. <u>Rv 3:20 & v21</u> 2 words are repeated; 2 similar acts
 - i. 2 words: w/Me. 2 act: sit w/ Jesus: dine w/ Me & sit w/ Me on throne.
 - ii. Connect Lord's Table & Lord's Throne. Those who open door in v20 are the overcomers of v21.
 - iii. <u>Lk 22:28-30</u> Lord's Supper = context for promise of Lord's Throne.

8th: The Command to Hear What the Spirit Says - <u>v22</u>

1. Learn "Trinitarian Grammar": enthroned Jesus [son] w/ Father, sends HS who speaks words that come from Jesus' mouth.

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2. The final promise to the overcomer in Rv 3 sets us up for Jn's vision of throne-room in Rv 4-5 - the setting for many scenes in Rv. Here is where our worship transpires in anticipation of our destined enthronement.

Applic #1: Take Responsibility for Your Zeal for Jesus

- 1. Be zealous & repent is "emotional obedience" possible? Aren't emotions involuntary rxns to stimuli? If so, place what is good before eye of faith & react w/ good emotions.
- 2. v18 I advise you to buy from Me... realize the value of true riches in Jesus.
- 3. Zeph 1:12-14a confess: stagnant heart Jesus says be zealous & repent
- 4. The concern is our love, Why idolatry = adultery; why heartless worship is a travesty of covenant love.

Applic #2: Keep Seeking the Things Above - Col 3:1-4 & Eph 2:4-7

- 1. Get heart into heaven before res'd body. Run race w/ eyes on Jesus.
- 2. Challenge: to love Jesus more than trinkets of Vanity Fair.

Applic #3: Engage Your Heart in the Means of Grace - Lord's Supper

- 1. Why do different Xns respond differently to the same means of grace?
- 2. Calibrate conscience evaluate comparative worth of what Mammon promises & what the enthroned King Jesus promises. *Do not judge according to appearance, but judge w/ righteous judgment* Jn 7:14
- 3. Come to LT, not only to remember what Jesus has done for you in the past, but *dine* w/ Him now a foretaste of the marriage feast of Lamb.
