I. The Background of Revelation 6.

- A. The events occur after the rapture. (I Cor. 15:51-58; I Thess. 4:13-18; Rev. 4-5)
- B. The events occur during the 70th week of Daniel. (Daniel 9:27)
- C. The events relate to the Olivet Discourse. (Matthew 24-25)

II. The Setting in Revelation 6.

- A. The Apostle John recalls what he saw and heard. (1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12)

- B. The Lamb breaks open 6 of the 7 seals from the scroll. (1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 12)

- C. The 4 Living Creatures command 4 different horses to come. (4:7; 6:1, 3, 5, 7)

- D. A Group of Martyrs ask the Lamb a question. (10-11)

- E. The General Population hides from the wrath of the Lamb. (12-17)

III. The Application from Revelation 6.

- A. Reflect on the wrath of the Lamb.
 - 1. His wrath is progressive. (1-8)

 - 2. His wrath is intentional. (9-11)

 - 3. His wrath is persuasive. (12-17)

- B. Respond to the wrath of the Lamb.
 - 1. Learn about Him from the Word.

 - 2. Talk with Him about your concerns. (10-11)

 - 3. Submit to Him with your life. (17)
