THE PASSOVER LAMB IS SET ASIDE



(Exodus 12:3) "Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:"

(Exodus 12:6) "And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening."

Jesus entered Jerusalem  
on the 10th of Nisan.

THE OLD TESTAMENT PREDICTED JESUS' TRIUMPHAL  
ENTRY INTO JERUSALEM

# 1. The Prophecy of the Colt:

(Mark 11:7) "And they brought the colt to Jesus, and cast their garments on him; and he sat upon him."

(Zechariah 9:9) "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass."

# 2. Daniel's 70 Weeks Prophecy: (Daniel 9:24-27)



(Daniel 9:26a) "And after  
threescore and two weeks  
shall Messiah be cut off,  
but not for himself..."

In this prophecy, each  
day of the week  
represents a year.

(Daniel 9:25) "Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times."

"the going forth of the  
commandment to  
restore and to build  
Jerusalem" = 445 BC  
in the month of Nissan

483 YEARS FROM THIS

MESSIAH WAS "CUT OFF"

# DANIEL'S "SEVENTY WEEKS"

DAN.9:24-27

24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself:

25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem, unto the Messiah the Prince, shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks:

27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

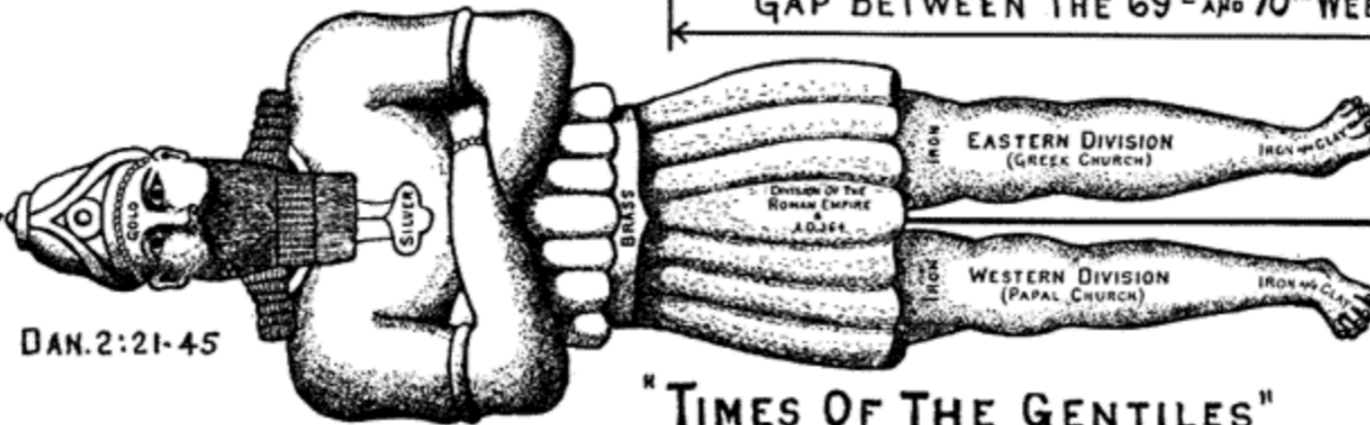

(Mark 11:10) "Blessed be  
the kingdom of our father  
David, that cometh in the  
name of the Lord:  
Hosanna in the highest."

HOSANNA  
= SAVE NOW

"Save now, I beseech thee, O  
LORD: O LORD, I beseech  
thee, send now prosperity.

Blessed be he that cometh in  
the name of the LORD: we  
have blessed you out of the  
house of the LORD."

(Psalm 118:25-26)

THEY EXPECTED THE
