# "Living In A Christless Culture" 1 Corinthians 10:23-30

### Introduction:

- 1. As We Head Back To 1 Corinthians 10 This Morning:
  - I Want You To Think About The Country & The Culture In Which We Live!
    - It Was Once Founded On Moral / Biblical / Christian Principles!
      - In 1796, President George Washington Stated In His Farewell Address: "It Is Impossible To
      - Rightly Govern The World Without God And The Bible!"
  - Look How Far Our Country & Our Culture Has Come!
    - Instead Of Seeking God & Using The Bible To Help Us Govern Our Lives!
      - We Are Seeing Millions Of Our Future Citizens Being Murdered Through Abortion And It Is Legal!
      - We Are Seeing A Battle For Morality Being Waged Throughout Our Country On The Validity Of Homosexual Marriage!
      - And We Continue To See Our Leaders & Politicians Making Decisions & Laws Not Based On Principles But For Pragmatics!
  - Our Culture Is Becoming More & More Christ-Less & God-Less!
    - But This Is Not Uncommon, Nor Is It Unusual!
      - Most Cultures Are This Way!
      - Our Country & Our Culture Is Extremely Different & Has Been Greatly Blessed!
      - The Christians & The Church In Corinth:
        - Were Living In Christless Society & Culture!
        - In Fact Their Culture Was Just Beginning To Taste The Influence Of Christianity! And It Was
        - A Shock To Their System!
- 2. So As We Continue Here In 1 Corinthians 10:
  - Need To Remember To Whom Paul Was Writing:
    - A Church In A Christless Culture!
  - And As Our Own Country & Culture:
    - Becomes More & More Christless:
      - We Will See That His Instruction Is More & More Important To Our Own Lives!
  - What We Will Look At This Morning Is:
    - How Can A Christian Live In A Christless Culture?
    - How Can A Christian Live In A Culture That Is Becoming More & More Christless?
  - We Will Explore Paul's Answer To This Question In 10:23-30!
    - Where Paul Is Summarizing & Finishing A Discussion He Began In Chapter 8 When He Was Asked
    - About How To Handle Things That Were Offered To Idols!
      - What Is A Christian To Do?
      - How Can A Christian Live In A Christless Culture?
    - Read 10:23-30!
- 3. How Can A Christian Continue To Live In A Christless Culture?

\* There Are Some:

## 1. Principles For Christian Living:

- 10:23-24 - "All things are lawful for me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but all things edify not. / Let no man seek his own, but every man another's wealth!"

- In These 2 Verses:

- Paul Is Explaining How He Personally Lived As A Christian In A Christless Culture! No Matter Where He Lived / No Matter Where He Went!

- Paul Experienced Christian Freedom & Liberty!
  - "All Things Are Lawful For Me!"
    - Or Permitted & Allowed!
  - Paul Is Not Talking About Sin!
    - But About Things That Are Not Clearly Dealt With In Scripture!
  - There Are Many Things In A Culture:
    - That Are Not Sinful To Participate In!
    - IE: Like: National Holidays / Technology / Certain Sports & Entertainments / Etc
- And A Christian Has Been Given Liberty To:

- Live By & Enjoy What Their Culture Has Produced!
- But As He Taught Previously There Are Limits To Our Liberty In Christ!
  - And These Are The Principles We Are To Live By In Order To Honor God & To Help Others!
- "All Things" May Be Lawful & Allowed For A Christian:
  - Even In A Christless Culture!
  - But There Are Three Basic Principles To How We Are To Live In a Christless Culture:
- First Principle For Living: Is It Helpful?
  - That Is Is What I Do & How I Live Truly Helpful!
    - To The Cause Of Christ & For The Walk Of Christians!
  - 10:23a "All Things Are Lawful For Me, But All Things Are Not Expedient!"
    - Paul Says There Are Some Things That I May Be Allowed & Permitted To Do But Not Everything That I Can Do, I Ought To Do!
      - Because It May Not Be Helpful!
      - "Expedient!" Or Profitable!
  - We Need To Limit What We Can Do:
    - By What Is Truly Helpful!
  - Does It Help?
    - Or Does It Hinder?
    - Your Own Personal Walk With The Lord?
    - Your Testimony & The Work Of The Gospel?
    - The Lives Of Others & Their Walk With God?
  - How Can A Christian Live In A Christless Culture?
    - By Living In A Way That Is Truly Helpful!
      - In A Way That Will Bless & Benefit Others!
- Second Principle For Living: Is It Heightening?
  - That Is Is What I Do & How I Live Bringing People, Especially Other Christians, Higher?
    - In The Grace & Knowledge Of God?
  - 10:23b "All Things Are Lawful For Me, But All Things Edify Not!"
    - Again Paul Says There Are Some Things That I May Be Allowed & Permitted To Do But Not
    - Everything That I Can Do, I Ought To Do!
      - Because It May Not Be Heightening!
        - "Edifying!" Or Building Up!
  - We Need To Limit What We Can Do:
    - By What Will Help Raise Christians To New Heights!
  - Does It Heighten?
    - Will What You Do Help Develop Other Christians & The Church Of Jesus Christ?
    - This Is Talking About True Spiritual Growth!
      - Did You Know There Are Two Types Of Growth In The Church? Spiritual / Numerical!
    - Acts 9:31 "Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied!"
      - The Spiritual Is To Come Before The Numerical!
  - And Our Focus Is To Help One Another:
    - Grow & Increase!
      - In The Knowledge Of Truth!
      - In Love For God & Others!
      - In Worship!
      - In Service For God & Others!
  - How Can A Christian Live In A Christless Culture?
    - By Living In A Way That Will Help Other Christians Reach New Heights Spiritually!
    - How Are You Living?
      - In A Way That Brings People To New Spiritual Heights? Or In A Way That Drags People To The Old Lows Of Life?
- Third Principle For Living: Is It Honoring?
  - That Is Is What I Do & How I Live Compatible:
    - With Romans 12:10 "In Honor Preferring One Another!"

- 10:24 - "Let No Man Seek His Own, But Every Man Another's Wealth!"

- Not Just Talking About The "Wealth" Of Others, But The "Life" Of Others!
- And We Need To Honor Others:
- And Focus On Their Needs / Concerns Even More Than Our Own!
- We Need To Limit What We Can Do As Christians:
  - By What Is Honoring & Thoughtful Of Others!

- Especially Other Christians, Whose Conscience Might Be Weaker Than Ours!

- This Takes Humility!

- Philippians 2:3-5 - "Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. / Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. / Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus!"

- How Can A Christian Live In A Christless Culture?

- By Reflecting The Mind / Life Of Christ In That Culture & To Every Person Around Them! - This Is The Principle That Must Govern Our Lives:

- If We Are Christians Living In A Christless Culture:

- As John The Baptist Said In John 3:30 - "He Must Increase (That Is – Jesus), But I Must Decrease!"

- Your Life Is Not All About You!
  - It Is About God / Christ / Others!

- IE: We Are To Be Like Chandeliers In The Middle Of A Dark, Christless Culture! Where The Light Of Christ & The Gospel Changes Us & Beautifies Us & Then Spreads The Light Out To Others!

- These 3 Principles Are Important In A Christless Culture:

- Be Helpful / Be Heightening - Edifying / Be Honoring - More Focused On The Spiritual Needs Of Others, Than Of Your Own Freedoms & Comforts!

### \* There Are Some:

# 2. Practices For Christian Living:

- In These Next Few Verses:

- Paul Gives Some Practical Answers To The Questions That Were Given To Him By The Church In Corinth!

- And These Answers Were Only Given After He Spend Nearly 3 Chapters Laying The Foundation / Principles For His Answer!

- 10:25-28 - "Whatsoever is sold in the shambles, that eat, asking no question for conscience sake: / 26 For the earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof. / 27 If any of them that believe not bid you to a feast, and ye be disposed to go; whatsoever is set before you, eat, asking no question for conscience sake. / 28 But if any man say unto you, This is offered in sacrifice unto idols, eat not for his sake that shewed it, and for conscience sake: for the earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof!"

- Why Didn't Paul Just Come Out With His Answers To Their Questions To Begin With?

- Because The Issue Is One Of The Heart, And Not Just Of Your Habits!

- Paul Was Concerned With Teaching Us How To Deal With All Areas Of Our Christian Lives! - So These Answers:

- That Deal Specifically With The Issues Of Eating Meat Offered To Idols - A Problem For That Church In That Christless Culture:

- Will Help Us Know How To Deal With Other Issues That We Face In Our Christless Culture!

- Remember God's Provision!

- 10:25-26 - The First Issue:

- Going To The Meat Market To Buy Meat That You Will Eat In Your Home - And That Meat Had Likely Been Offered In Sacrifice To An Idol!

- What Does Paul Tell Them?

- "Whatsoever is sold in the shambles, that eat, asking no question for conscience sake: / For the earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof!"

- To The Corinthians In Their Christless Culture:
  - If You Have A Common Physical Need: To Eat!
  - And There Is A Common Place To Buy: Shamble!
  - Then Don't Worry About Whether Or Not The Meat Was Offered To Idols Previously!
  - Instead: Use What God Has Given To You!
    - And Live Where God Has Placed You!

- You Cannot Control Everything That Goes On In The Marketplace!

- Just Don't Ask Questions Or Investigate:

- Where The Meat Came From!

- To Other Christians In A Christless Culture:

- If You Have A Common Need!

- And There Is A Common Place To Buy!
- Then Don't Worry About How Your Money Is Used By That Company!
- IE: Need Some Things Around The Home Go Out And Get What You Need Not Asking
- Questions About Where Your Money Goes May Even Go To Support Sinful Lifestyles (Probably Does)! You Have The Liberty To Go Or Not Go There!
- Remember God's Provision!
  - 10:26 "For The Earth Is The Lord's, And The Fulness Thereof!"
  - A Quote From Psalm 24:1!
  - All That Is In The World Has Been Given To Us By God!
    - By His Grace & As A Gift!
      - To Provide For Our Needs!
      - To Use / To Enjoy!
      - 1 Timothy 6:17 "Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded,
      - nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy!"
- So Even In A Christless Culture:
  - You Can With A Clear Conscience Enjoy What God Provides For You, Even Through That Culture!
  - Just Do So With A Grateful Heart!
    - Not Investigating Things In Detail!
      - And Receive Them As God's Gift To You!
- Remember God's Possession!
  - 10:27-28 The Second Issue:

- Going To Eat At A Feast Where The Meat Offered To You Was Likely Offered In Sacrifice To An Idol!

- What Does Paul Tell Them?

- 10:27 - "If any of them that believe not bid you to a feast, and ye be disposed to go; whatsoever is set before you, eat, asking no question for conscience sake!"

- To The Corinthians In Their Christless Culture:
  - If You Are Invited By An Unbeliever To A Meal / Feast!
    - And This Would Have Been Common There Were Labor Guilds / Unions Feasts Were A Common Way To Get Together / Socialize / Transact Business! **IE:** Common
    - Now As Well! Business Parties! Some Voluntary / Others Mandatory!
  - If You Decide To Go Again An Issue Of Liberty:
    - Then Don't Worry About Whether Or Not The Meat Was Offered To Idols Previously!
    - Just Don't Ask Questions Or Investigate:
      - Where The Meat Came From!

- BUT - 10:28 - "But if any man say unto you, This is offered in sacrifice unto idols, eat not for his sake that shewed it, and for conscience sake!"

- If Someone Tells You That The Meat Was Sacrificed To An Idol Don't Eat It!
- They May Tell You: To Inform / To Investigate Test / To Impress You!
- For The Same Of:
  - Testimony To Unbelievers!
  - Conscience Of Christians!
- Don't Eat It!
- To Other Christians In A Christless Culture:
  - If Something Is Being Sold / Placed Before You:
  - And "A Portion Of The Proceeds Will Go To Support "- What Is The Blank?
  - If Something Is Known To Directly:
    - Support / Serve Something Clearly Unbiblical / Sinful / Wrong Do Not Participate In

It!

- Remember God's Possession!
  - 10:28b "For The Earth Is The Lord's, And The Fulness Thereof!"

- Same Quote From Psalm 24:1!

- Different Emphasis!

- All That Is In The World Belongs To God!

- He Alone Deserves The Glory For It!

- Isaiah 42:8 - "I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images!"

- So - Even In A Christless Culture:

- You Can Live Out & Practice Your Christian Walk:

- By Remembering:

- God's Provision!

- But Also God's Possession!

- "For The Earth Is The Lord's & The Fulness Thereof!"

## \* There Is Also:

### 3. A Purpose For Living:

- 10:29-30 - "Conscience, I say, not thine own, but of the other: for why is my liberty judged of another man's conscience? / For if I by grace be a partaker, why am I evil spoken of for that for which I give thanks?"

- We Need To Be People That Are Concerned!

- About The Right Things!

- And How Our Lives Affect Those Around Us!

- Not Just Unbelievers - Testimony!

- But Believers Church!
- Paul Lived With Concern!

- We Must Too! Purpose For Living!

- Concern For Conscience!

- 10:29a - "Conscience, I Say, Not Thine Own, But Of The Other!"

- Even With Our Freedom / Liberty In Christ:

- We Need To Have A Concern For The Conscience Of Other Christians!

- Who May Still Be Dealing With & Struggling With Some Issues In Their Life / Walk With Christ!

- They Have A Weaker Conscience Than You!

- Need To Be Concerned For Them!

- And You Need To Defer To Them & Their Conscience!

- You May Not Have An Issue / Problem - But Does Another Christian Who You Know & Will

See You? Will It Cause Them To Struggle? Even Sin?

- This Is Part Of Our Purpose For Living:

- A Concern For The Conscience Of Others!

- Concern For Conduct!

- 10:29b - "For Why Is My Liberty Judged Of Another Man's Conscience?"

- Here - Paul Is Stating Something That He Does Not Want To Happen!

- If He Were To Go Along With His Liberty, Without Care Or Concern For Others!

- In Effect He Is Asking:

- "Why Should I Permit – By The Use Of My Liberty – Someone To Call My Conduct Into Question?"

- And Judge Him & Think That He Is Wilfully Sinning!

- We See Here Acts 24:16 In Action:

- "And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men!"

- He Didn't Want To In Any Way:
  - Offend The Church / Other Christians!
  - More Importantly The Testimony Of God & The Gospel!

- So - He Was Willing To Limit His Liberty Out Of Love!

- This Is Part Of Our Purpose For Living:

- A Concern About Our Conduct For Christ!

- Acts 24:16!

- Concern For Character!

- 10:30 - "For if I by grace be a partaker, why am I evil spoken of for that for which I give thanks?"

- Here Again - Paul Is Stating Something That He Does Not Want To Happen!

- If He Were To Go Along With His Liberty, Without Care Or Concern For Others!

- Again He Is Asking:
  - "Why Should I Permit By The Use Of My Liberty Someone To Call My Character Into Question?"
    - And Speak Against Him & His Ministry & Even His Master, The Lord Jesus Christ!
- Even Though We Experience God's Grace / Gifts:
  - In Many Practical Things In Our Lives!
  - It Is Better To Give Something Up, Than For Your Character & The Character Of Your Lord, To Be Spoken Against!
- We Have A Purpose For Living In Our Christless Culture!
  - And We Need To Be Concerned About How The Way We Live / Act Is Received In The Culture & In The Church!

## **Conclusion:**

1. It Is Never Easy For A Christian To Live In A Christless Culture!

- But This Is How God Chooses To Shine His Light In The Darkness!
  - He Uses His People!
  - Remember:
    - These Principles For Living!
    - Your Practices For Living!
    - Your Purpose For Living!

- And Remember Matthew 5:14-16 - "Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. / Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. / Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven!"
