- X. Antichrists and Christians
 - A. Characteristics of Antichrists vs 18-19,22-23,26
 - 1. Introduction of Antichrists vs 18
 - a. Little children
 - i. *paidion* a childling (of either sex), an infant, a half-grown boy or girl; an immature Christian:--(little, young) child, damsel.
 - ii. Identifies them as children of God 2:13
 - iii. Those the Father wants to warn of impending danger and serious threat b. it is the last hour/ by which we know that it is the last hour
 - i. refers to the present evil age of two ages/ the other being the age to come
 - ii. The last hour started at the 1st coming of Christ Ga 4:4; Heb 1:1-2; 1Pe 1:20
 - iii. It ends at the 2nd coming
 - iv. The age to come encompasses all events afterwards -
 - c. you have heard that the Antichrist is coming
 - i. 1st NT use of the term
 - ii. understood from the OT Dan 7:8; 9:26-27; Zec 11:15-17
 - iii. Repeated by Christ Mt 24:15-25;
 - iv. Taught by Paul
 - 2 Th 2:1-12 wouldn't happen until "the apostasy"
 - 1 Tim 4:1-3 what brings the apostasy?
 - d. even now many antichrists have come
 - i. with Christ's 1st coming. demonic activity spiked as not seen before or since
 - ii. As we get closer to the 2nd coming,
 - false teaching seems to be on the increase, leading to
 - the ultimate deception of the worship of the antichrist of the tribulation
 - 2. Their Characteristics vs 19, 22-23, 26
 - a. They leave the fellowship They went out from us, but they were not of us;
 - i. if the were truly saved for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; Jo 10:28-29; 2Ti 2:19-21
 - ii. but they went out that they might be made manifest, that none of them were of us. Ac 20:30
 - 111
 - b. They deny the faith Who is a liar
 - i. but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ?
 - the Person and Work of Jesus Christ is fundamental to salvation **Jo 8:24**; Ac 4:12; **Ro 10:9-10**
 - genuine salvation requires embracing
 - -Him as Messiah Jo 1:49;
 - -that He is the one and only God/Man 1 Ti 2:5; Tit 2:13
 - -obeying the Gospel Mk 1:15; Jo 3:36; 15:10
 - ii. He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son.
 - Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.
 - God is inseparable 1:3; 4:2-3, 9-10

- to deny the essence of the one is to deny the essence of the whole - Mt 11:27; Lk 9:27; Jo 17:5, 21-23; 1Jo 2:22-24

- c. by nature they try to confuse the faithful
 - i. These things I have written to you concerning those who try to deceive you. vs 26
 - ii. True believers are not so easily deceived Mt 24:24; Mt 24:2Th 2:9-11; 2Ti 2:19; 1Jo 3:7; 2Jo 7-8; Re 13:13
- B. Characteristics of Christians vs 20-21, 24-25, 27
 - 1. Accept the Faith vs 20-21, 27
 - a. But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things.
 - i. *chrisma* an unguent or smearing, the special endowment ("chrism") of the Holy Spirit:--anointing, unction.
 - ii. One ministry of the Holy Spirit is to lead us into truth 2Co 1:21-22; Jo 14:26; 16:13
 - b. I have not written to you because you do not know the truth,
 - i. but because you know it,
 - ii. and that no lie is of the truth.
 - iii. You cannot have it both ways, truth and lies 1Co 2:12-16
 - c. But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you,
 - i. permanently Jo 14:16-17; Ro 8:9; Eph 1:13
 - and you do not need that anyone teach you; Eph 4:11-12
 - but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things,
 - I and is true, and is not a lie
 - ii. just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
 - 2. Remain Faithful vs 24-25
 - a. your participation Therefore let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning.
 - i. *meno* to stay (in a given place, state, relation or expectancy), abide, continue, dwell, endure, be present, remain, stand, tarry
 - ii. what you heard from the beginning the truth
 - b. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, Jo 14:23
 - i. you also will abide in the Son
 - ii. and in the Father.
 - c. Then And this is the promise that He has promised us--eternal life.
 - i. Jo 17:3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
 - ii. 1Jo 1:2 the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us--
 - iii. 1Jo 5:11 And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.
