## ARE YOU BEING TRANSFORMED? Pt. 1

(12 Principles for Spiritual Transformation in Your Life) Romans 12:2b

- I. THE EXHORTATION OF GRACE (12:1)
- II. THE ELEMENTS OF THE EXHORTATION (12:1c-2) In light of the tremendous mercies of God toward you in past justification by grace, present sanctification by grace, and future glorification by grace ...
  - A. PRESENT YOUR BODY TO GOD ... "as a living sacrifice ... reasonable service." (12:1) This is an appeal to true spirituality and spiritual worship because of a logical and volitional response to the mercies of God.
  - B. DO NOT BE CONFORMED to this WORLD ... "And do not be conformed to this world" (12:2a) This is a command to <u>not</u> be conformed to the standards, values, philosophies, purposes, pursuits, etc. of the age or period of time you live in.
  - **C. BUT BE TRANSFORMED BY THE RENEWING OF YOUR MIND.** (12:2b) This is an imperative from God concerning spiritual growth and the spiritual transformation He wants to accomplish in every believer's thinking or mindset.
    - "But" (alla) –
      "be transformed" (metamorphoo) –
      "by the (ho) renewing" (anakainos) "of our mind" (ho nous) –

• Let's understand the *meaning* of our words:

- Let's grasp 12 principles about spiritual growth and transformation in your life:
  - 1. Spiritual growth and transformation are only for \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, not the unsaved who are still in need of spiritual regeneration. (12:1a; 1 Peter 1:23-2:2)
  - 2. Spiritual growth and transformation are motivated in your life by the \_\_\_\_\_\_ due to the love of God, the finished work of Christ, the believer's security, identification and emancipation in Christ as a new creation, the indwelling and power of the Holy Spirit, the plan, purposes, and promises of God, etc. (12:1a)

3.	Spiritual growth and transformation require an understanding of God's grace and an attitude of gratitude with repeated choices to logically yourself to the Lord. (12:1c)
4.	Spiritual growth and transformation involve your willingness to
	to the norms, standards, philosophies, and purposes of this age. (12:2a)
5.	Spiritual growth and transformation are a that you must personally embrace (imperative mood) though you cannot fulfill this reality apart from God's grace – like salvation. (12:2b; 2 Tim. 2:15; Heb. 4:11, 11:7; 1 Pet. 2:2; 2 Pet. 3:17-18)
