Communication of the Evangel

- Communication can involve many things the science of conveying a message by the spoken work, in writing, or by acting.
- 2. It can be a matter of personality rather than technique
 - A. Certain personalities can be more effective at communicating a message
- 3. Scripture accounts for this by emphasizing that the primary means of salvation is through the preaching of the Word.
 - A. Phillip and the Ethiopian (Acts 8:26-39)
 - B. Paul stresses the importance of preaching the Word
 - 1) Rom 10:14
 - 2) 1 Cor 1:18, 21

The Evangelist

- 1. Must have a clear understanding of the gospel.
- 2. Have a strong conviction as the truth of the gospel.
 - A. Paul shows this in his words in 2 Cor 4:13 and 1 Cor 15:3-4
- 3. Have a lively sense of the supreme importance of the gospel. (our eternal destiny depends upon belief of the message)
- 4. He must himself experienced the saving power of the gospel (2 Tim 1:12).
- 5. He must be compelled by a passion for lost souls (2 Cor 5:20)
- 6. Have an overwhelming love for the Savior (When I survey the Wondrous cross)
- 7. "Such communication the Lord is wont to bless and use" Kuiper

Bestowal of conversion

- 1. The task of the evangelist is to communicate the *gospel* to men
- 2. To impart to man *faith in the gospel* is God's prerogative.
- 3. Saving faith is not a gift of the evangelist, it is a gift of God (Eph 2:8)
- 4. Faith is wrought in the human heart by the Holy Spirit (1 Cor 12:3)
- 5. Lydia Acts 16:14
- 6. The Evangelist is completely dependent upon God for the effectiveness of his labors (1 Cor 3:5-7)

Chosen by God

- 1. The ultimate explanation for a person coming to faith lies in God's sovereign election
- 2. Matt 22:14 "Many are called, but few are chosen"
 - A. Of the many called by the gospel, the few who believe do so because they were divinely chosen to that end from eternity.
 - B. "As many who were ordained to eternal life believed" Acts 13:48
 - C. God did the ordaining
 - D. God made good the ordaining by imparting of saving faith
- 3. Spurgeon story of meeting a drunkard on the streets
- 4. Ezk 37:5-6 God breaths life into the spiritually dead as we preach the word
- 5. The unconverted must receive a new heart Ezk 11:19
- 6. Rebirth needed to embrace the gospel in faith (1 Cor 2:14)
- 7. Man's boasting excluded (Esp 2:8-9, 1 Cor 1:31)
- 8. All the glory of conversion is God's (Rom 11:36)

Accurately appraising the results of evangelism

- 1. Only God can count converts.
- 2. Don't become frustrated with your efforts.
 - A. Robert Morrison 10 converts in 28 years of missionary work in China
 - B. Hudson Taylor
- 3. Be faithful to preach the good news and let God "show out"
- 4. Examples of God's sovereign works (John 4:31-38, the sower & reaper)
- 5. Pg 221 example from Baxter to Chalmers
- 6. Paul
- 7. Jesus (John 12:32)
- 8. Our role is to be obedient in proclaiming the gospel Taylor quote
