INTRODUCTION: DEFEDNING THE FAITH

Madness is a quality of genuine faith in Jesus.

The Gospel of John was written to articulate what it means to have true faith in Jesus. So far, we have learned that true faith is the result of being born again. True faith results in true worship. True faith results in obedience. In John 12, we will see that true faith in Jesus will result in madness -at least from the world's point of view.

Madness

carried away by enthusiasm or desire: extremely or excessively fond of or enthusiastic about something or someone often resulting in action that others might deem crazy

2 Samuel 6:16

Then it happened *as* the ark of the Lord came into the city of David that Michal the daughter of Saul looked out of the window and saw King David leaping and dancing before the Lord; and she despised him in her heart.

2 Samuel 6:21

So David said to Michal, "It was before the Lord, who chose me above your father and above all his house, to appoint me ruler over the people of the Lord, over Israel; therefore I will celebrate before the Lord.
