All Israel Will Be Saved Romans 11:23–32

The Holy Spirit uses the metaphor of an olive tree to explain God's plan for Israel.

- v. 16 The fathers were set-apart for God's purpose then so are the children of Israel.
- v. 17 Israel has been disqualified while Gentiles have been accepted.
- v. 18–22 Gentile believers should be humble about their undeserved position.

And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. For if you were cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, who are natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree? - God is so great that just as Gentiles received a privileged position through faith, Israel can also be restored through faith.

For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

- God wants us to be fully aware of a truth that He has kept hidden until now.
- There are two aspects to Israel's blindness: 1) Israel's blindness is partial not total (11:5); 2) Israel's blindness is temporary not permanent.
- God blinded Israel (11:7–10) and in the future God will end the blindness of Israel
 when the total number of the elect among the Gentiles are brought into the
 kingdom.

And so all Israel will be saved, - In the future, there will be a sweeping event when every single ethnic Israelite will be saved - **Zechariah 13:7–9**

as it is written: "THE DELIVERER WILL COME OUT OF ZION, AND HE WILL TURN AWAY UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB; FOR THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS." - The salvation of the nation of Israel will be a sovereign work of God through the new covenant - Isaiah 59:20–21

Concerning the gospel they are enemies for your sake, but concerning the election they are beloved for the sake of the fathers - Israel is currently in rebellion against God. But because of His sovereign election, unconditional promises, and unchanging love He will never completely and finally forsake them.

For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy. - God has reversed the position of Jews and Gentiles to show the greatness of His mercy.

For God has committed them all to disobedience, that He might have mercy on all. - God's mercy can only be extended to people who don't deserve it.

Only God can save the unsavable! Have you recognized yourself as unsavable? We will never fully comprehend how and why God could save a sinner like me!


