Acts 6:12 - Acts 8:3

- I. Three flashpoints
 - A. The land: Stephen demonstrated that the Gospel of God is not for a special people, but for the world.
 - B. The law: Stephen showed that salvation cannot be through obedience to the law, but by faith in the lawgiver.
 - C. The temple: Stephen claimed worship does not occur because of a place of worship, but through the presence of the Holy Spirit.
- II. Three rejected men
 - A. Joseph: The rejected man became a savior.
 - B. Moses: The savior became a rejected man.
 - C. Jesus: The rejection of the true Savior resulted in eternal death.
