What does Paul say about the mystery he is discussing? What is a Biblical mystery? Read Romans 16:25-26. How does this mystery impact his Gentile audience? What phrases speak of the unity there should be among believers? How did Paul view his service to the Lord? How can understanding what God is doing through the church motivate us to guard the unity of the Body and advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

Ephesians 3:8-13

What is Paul's goal in preaching? How did Jesus Christ change Paul's life? How has your life been transformed by God's grace? Why do Christians struggle to share the Gospel? How can developing a Biblical perspective of what God is doing motivate you to tell others? How can you encourage others to advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ?
