- Nicodemus:

- Who Understood The Biblical Definition:

- Of Heaven - And:

- Had A Great Desire:

- To Enter Into The Kingdom Of God!

- And Even Though:

- Thousands Of Years Separate Us:

- From Nicodemus:

- What Jesus Says To Him:

- Still Resonates With All Who Have The Same Desire - And Even:

1. The Same Pursuit:

- As Nicodemus - A Pursuit After:

- The Kingdom Of God!

- So - As We Begin Our Look At This Profound Chapter - John 3:

- Let's Read Together John 3:1-8!

- "There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: / The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. / Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. / Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? / Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and [of] the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. / That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. / Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. / The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit!"

- And So - He Pursued It:

- With Sincerity!

- In 3:1 - We Are Told That:

- Nicodemus Was:

- "A Man Of The Pharisees!"

- Now - We Saw This Group Earlier:

- In John 1 - When Several Pharisees:

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- Went To Find Out Who John The Baptist:

                                          - He Was Baptizing People!
        - Well - Nicodemus' Religious Persuasion:
                 - Was That Of A Pharisee!
                         - Which Meant That He Was Very Particular In His Commitment:
                                  - To The Jewish Law & Traditions!
                                          - "Pharisee" - To Distinguish!
                 - And So - He Would Have Tried To Keep:
                         - Every Letter Of God's Law:
                                  - In Pursuit Of:
                                          - God's Pleasure & Reward!
        - Nicodemus Pursued Heaven:
                 - With Great Sincerity!
                         - But - Was It Enough?
                 - No - Because As Jesus Told Him In 3:3:
                         - "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God!"
        - But - Nicodemus Also Pursued After Heaven:
- With Sagacity - With Wisdom!
        - Also In 3:1 - We Are Told That:
                 - He Was:
                         - "A Ruler Of The Jews!"
        - More Than Likely:
                 - This Meant That He Was A Member Of:
                         - The Jewish Sanhedrin!
                 - A Group Of 70 Jewish Elders:
                         - That Was First Composed By Moses!
        - And So - Nicodemus:
                 - Would Have Been A Respected Leader:
                         - Of The Jews!
                                  - Respected For His Position:
                                          - And For His Wisdom!
                 - Wisdom About:
                         - The Word Of God - And:
                                  - About The Ways Of God!
        - And So - Nicodemus Would Have Pursued Heaven:
                 - With Great Sagacity!
                         - Much More Than The Average Jew!
                                 - But - Was It Enough?
                 - No - Because As Jesus Told Him Again In 3:5:
                         - "Except a man be born of water and [of] the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of
                         God!"
        - But - Nicodemus Also Pursued After Heaven:
- With Sensitivity!
        - In 3:2 - We Are Told That:
                 - Nicodemus - "Came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher
                 come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him!"
        - More Than Likely:
                 - Nicodemus Was One Of Those:
                         - That We Read About In Chapter 2:23:
                                  - Who Even - "Believed In Jesus' Name, When They Saw The Miracles Which
                                  He Did!"
        - So - There Was A Sensitivity:
                 - In The Heart Of Nicodemus:
                         - That Caused Him:
                                  - To Want To Know More!
        - And So - With All Of His:
                 - Religious Sincerity & Sagacity & Sensitivity:
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- He "Came To Jesus By Night!" - To Seek & To Find Out: - Who Jesus Was! - Now - He May Have Come: - At Night - Out Of Some Fear: - But - That Fear Was Still Mingled: - With Some Faith & Hope! - Because - He Still "Came To Jesus!" - So - Nicodemus Pursued After Heaven: - With Great Sensitivity! - Even Seeking After Jesus Himself! - But - Was This Enough? - No - Because Jesus Told Him A Third Time: - In 3:7 - "Ye Must Be Born Again!" - There Are Many People: - In The World & Even In The Church: - Who - Like Nicodemus: - Not Only Believe: - In A Heaven! - But Are Pursuing After Heaven: - With Great Sincerity & Sensitivity: - Seeking After The Kingdom Of God: - With All Their Heart! - But - Is This Enough? - Some Of These People: - Perhaps Including Some Of You: - Are Very Religious! - They Know God's Word! - They Know Even The Gospel! - But - Is This Knowledge: - And Wisdom Enough? - Religious Sincerity: - Biblical Sagacity: - And Even Spiritual Sensitivity: - Are Not Enough For Anyone: - To Enter The Kingdom Of God! - And That Is Because: - We All Have: The Same Problem: - As Nicodemus - That Keeps Us From: - The Kingdom Of God! - In 3:1 - Nicodemus Is First Described As: - "A Man!" - And - As "A Man" - He Was: - A Fallen. Sinful Man: - Because He Had The Same Parents: - We All Have In Common: - Adam & Eve! - And His Problem: - Is Our Problem! - Because We Are Sinners: - The Gates Of God's Holy Kingdom: - Are Closed To Us! - And - Deep Down: - Nicodemus Knew This! - Because - After A Life Filled With: - Seeking After The Things Of God:

- He Was Still Troubled! - He Was Still Uncertain! - And - That Is Why: - In 3:3 - We Are Told That: - "Jesus Answered" Nicodemus! - But - What Was His Ouestion? - None Given In The Text! - But - Instead Of Beating Around The Bush: - Like Nicodemus Was: - Jesus Addresses & Answers The Question In His Heart! - In Ecclesiastes 3:11: - We Are Told That: - God Has "Set The World / Eternity In Their Heart!" - A Desire For Eternity! - A Desire For Immortality! - A Desire For Heaven! - And - The Only Way: - For A Sinner To Get There: - The Only Way: - For You To Get There Is: - To Be Born Again! - And So - Three Times: - Jesus Gives Us The Solution: - To Our Common Problem! - First - There Needs To Be: - A Second Birth! - 3:3 - "Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God!" - Jesus Uses The Phrase "Verily, Verily" 25 Times In John - Always To Deliver: - A Statement Of Serious & Perpetual Truth! - So - Need To Pay Attention! - Especially Since This Answer Applies Not Just To Nicodemus But To Everyone! - The Word Translated "Again" In This Verse: - Can Also Be Translated "From Above!" - So - Jesus Is Talking About: - Another Birth - But One: - That Is Different & Higher Than Physical Birth Into This World! - And - Though This Is A True Statement: - It Boggled The Mind Of: - Nicodemus! - His Mind & His Heart: - Like Ours - Was So: - Earth-Bound: - He Could Only Think In Terms Of Physical, Natural Birth! - And So - He Asked Jesus: - Perhaps With A Sense Of Despair: - "How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?" - How Did Jesus Respond To: - Nicodemus' Misunderstanding? - Not With Condemnation, But With Compassion! - And So - In 3:5 - He Repeats Himself: - In Terms Nicodemus Would Have Understood! - And - How There Needs To Be: - A Special Birth! - "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and [of] the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God!" - Now - Some Have Seen In These Words:

- Not Greater Clarity - But: - Greater Confusion! - Is Jesus Talking About: - Two Births Here? - "Water" - Referring To: - Physical, Natural Birth! - "Spirit" - Referring To: - Spiritual, Heavenly Birth! - If So - Then Its Not Much Clearer: - Than What He Just Said In 3:3! Or: - Is Jesus Talking About: - The Manner Of The New Birth? - With "Water" Referring To: - Repentance & Baptism! - With "Spirit" Referring To: - Regeneration & Faith! - If So - Then Jesus Is Saying That: - You & I Have Something To Do: - With Being Born Again! - Which Is Contrary To What We Find Later! - Instead - Jesus Is Explaining To Nicodemus: - What It Means To Be: - "Born Again" - 3:3 - In Biblical Terms: - He Would Have Or Should Have: - Understood! - The Best Way To Translate 3:5 Is This: - "Except A Man Be Born Of Water And Spirit!" - Not Referring Here To The Holy Spirit - But To The Transformation Brought About By The Spirit! - In Ezekiel 36:25-26 - We Have A Special Prophecy: - About This Kind Of Transformation: - That We All Need! And: - Which The Lord Alone Can Provide! - "Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. / A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh!" - I Believe This Is What Jesus Had In Mind: - When He Explained To Nicodemus: - What He Meant By Being: - "Born Again!" - There Must Be: - A Divine Cleansing: - "From All Your Filthiness!" - And - There Must Be: - A Divine Change: - So That You Have A "New Spirit" Within You! - And - Who Alone Can: - Do This? "I" - 6 Times! The Lord! - And - When This Happens: - It Is Likened To A New Birth! - A Heavenly Birth - Which Makes You Into: - An Entirely New Creation! - 2 Corinthians 5:17 - "Therefore if any man [be] in Christ, [he is] a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new!" - But - This Birth - Is Nothing Like: - Your Physical Birth! - Because - It Is:

- A Spiritual Birth!

- As Jesus Adds - In 3:6:

- "That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit!"

- The Kind Of Transformation:

- Jesus Described In 3:5:

- Divine Cleansing & Divine Change:

- Can Only Come About:

- By The Spirit Of God!

- The Problem Nicodemus Had:

- Is The Same Problem:

- That You & I Have!

- We Are Sinful People:

- Who Have Inherited:

- The Sinful Flesh That Has Been Passed Down To Us! Generation!

- But - The Solution Given To Nidocemus:

- Is The Same Solution:

- That You & I Need!

- We Must Be Born Again! Anew! From Above!

- We Must Be Cleansed! Changed! Transformed!

- We Must Be Translated From The Kingdom Of This World To The Kingdom

Of God & His Dear Son!

- But - How Can This Take Place?

- How Can This Happen?

- Well - In 3:8 - We Find That:

- We Have:

3. The Same Provision:

- As Nicodemus - To See & Enter The Kingdom Of God!

- 3:8 - "The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit!"

- In This Verse - Jesus Illustrates:

- The Work Of The Holy Spirit:

- With The Effects Of The Wind!

- And - His Point Is This - The New Birth:

- That Is Absolutely Necessary:

- Is Not Something That Can Be Done By You!

- It Is Something That Is Done *To* You & *For* You:

- By The Spirit Of God!

- You Can Only Be Born Again:

- According To:

- The Will Of The Spirit!

- Just Like The Wind:

- 3:8 - "Bloweth Where It Listeth!"

- Or - It "Blows Wherever It Wants / Pleases!"

- Of Course - Wind Has No Will!

- But - Jesus Here Gives It Some Personality!

- But - Wind Is Unpredictable!

- Even By Those Whose Job It Is:

- To "Predict" It! Yet It Is Unpredictable:

- In Its Drive / Direction / Duration / Danger!

- So Is The Will Of The Holy Spirit:

- When It Comes To Being Born Again!

- He Moves Upon The Hearts Of Men:

- According To His Own Will And Pleasure!

- Because - He Is God!

- Also - You Can Only Be Born Again:

According To:

- The Word Of The Spirit!

- Even As The Wind:

- 3:8 - Has A "Sound" Or "Voice" That You Can Hear!

- Though The Wind Has No Mouth:

- You Can Still Hear It!

- Sometimes Softly, As It Brushes By Your Hear!

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- Sometimes Loudly, As It Pushes Through Whatever Is In Its Way!
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- So Is The Word Of The Holy Spirit:

- When It Comes To Being Born Again!

- He Speaks To The Hearts Of Men:

- Through His Word In Different Ways - But:

- When He Speaks, Nothing Can Get In His Way!

- Isaiah 55:11 - "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] whereto I sent it!"

- Also - You Can Only Be Born Again:

- According To:

- The Ways Of The Spirit!

- Even As - 3:8 - You Cannot Tell:

- Where The Wind Comes From & Where It Goes!

- Of Course - Today - We Have Some Sense Of The Wind's Ways - High & Low

Pressure Systems!

- But - Still - Wind Remains Unpredictable:

- Even In Our Scientific Age!

- So Are The Ways Of The Holy Spirit:

- When It Comes to Being Born Again!

- Jesus Adds - 3:8 - "So Is Every One That Is Born Of The Spirit!"

- The Provision - That Nicodemus Needed - And:

- The Provision - That You & I Need:

- To See & To Enter The Kingdom Of God:

- Is Entirely Dependant Upon:

- The Will & The Word & The Ways Of The Holy Spirit Of God!

- "Ye Must Be Born Again!"

Conclusion:

This Teaching Of Jesus: 1 - Can Be A Hard Teaching! - You Mean - I Have Nothing To Do: - With Being Born Again? From Above? - You Have As Much To Do: - With Being Born Spiritually: - As You Had: - When You Were Born Physically! 2. Which Is Why Jesus Told Nicodemus: - In 3:7 - "Marvel Not!" - The Marvel & The Wonder: - Is Not *How*: - Someone Is Born Again! - The Marvel & The Wonder: - Is Not When: - Someone Is Born Again! - The Marvel & The Wonder: - Is Not Even Who: - Is Born Again By The Spirit Of God! - The Marvel & The Wonder: - Is Why Anyone: - Would Be Born Again! - The Marvel & The Wonder: - Is Why The Holy Spirit:

- Would Move Upon The Heart Of Any Of Us:

- To Believe On Christ & His Gospel!
 - Which Becomes The Evidence Of Being Born Again!
- To Cleanse & Change Us!
- And To Bring Us Into The Kingdom Of God!

- Captured This Marvel & Wonder - When He Wrote These Words:

- I know not why God's wondrous grace

to me is daily shown, nor why, with mercy, Christ in love

redeemed me for his own.

- I know not how this saving faith

to me he did impart,

nor how believing in his word

wrought peace within my heart.

- I know not how the Spirit moves,

convincing us of sin,

revealing Jesus through the Word,

creating faith in him.

- But "I know whom I have believed,

and am persuaded that he is able

to keep that which I've committed

unto him against that day!"
