## Westminster Confession of Faith 29.3 (Of The Lord's Supper)

The Lord Jesus hath, in this ordinance, appointed His ministers to declare His word of institution to the people; to pray, and bless the elements of bread and wine, and thereby to set them apart from a common to an holy use; and to take and break the bread, to take the cup, and (they communicating also themselves) to give both to the communicants;<sup>a</sup> but to none who are not then present in the congregation.<sup>b</sup>
