 - -meekness, longsuffering, gentleness, patience, kind tempers, government of the tongue
 - -temperance and self-denial
 - -charity and brotherly kindness
 - -purity of heart
 - -humility
 - -faithfulness

Progressive Sanctification

"I do not say for a moment that holiness shuts out the presence of indwelling sin. No far from it. It is the greatest misery of a holy man that he carries about with him a body of death; that often when he would do good, evil is trying to draw him back at every step he takes..." Ryle pg. 68

The Importance of Practical Holiness

We must be holy because:

- 1. The voice of God in Scripture commands it (Matthew 5:48, Philippians 3:12-14)
- 2. This is one grand end and purpose for which Christ came into the world (Eph. 5:25-26, Titus 2:14)
- 3. This is the only sound evidence that we have a saving faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. (James 2:17)

The Importance of Practical Holiness (continued)

We Must be Holy Because...

- 4. This is the only proof that we love the Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity (John 14:15)
- 5. This is the only sound evidence that we are true children of God
- 6. This is the most likely way to do good to others

The Importance of Practical Holiness (continued)

We Must be Holy Because...

- 7. Our present comfort depends much upon it. (1 John 3:18-19)
- 8. Without holiness on earth we shall never be prepared to enjoy heaven
