

Sermon Notes for Sunday, April 12, 2020

1 Corinthians 15:1-26 “Eternal Life by Faith in the Risen Christ”

1. Basics of faith: Believing the gospel of Christ’s death, burial and, resurrection (v. 1-4)

2. Faith with evidence: The historical reality of Christ’s resurrection (v. 5-11)

3. If our faith were pointless: What if the dead are not really raised? (v. 12-19)

4. Faith with a point: Eternal life in Christ (v. 20-16)
