The Judgment of Man (part 1) Revelation 20:4-6, 11-15

I. JUBILATION: "came to life...and reigned...blessed and holy"(vv.4-6)

- **A. Examination:** "they came to life and reigned with Christ" (v.4)
 - 1. Multiple Thrones: "thrones...judgment was given to them"
 - 2. Martyred Souls: "the souls of those who had been beheaded"
 - a. Reason: "beheaded because of the testimony of Jesus"
 - b. Resistance: "had not worshiped the beast"
 - c. Refusal: "had not received the mark"
 - 3. Mutual Rulers: "came to life and reigned with Christ"
- **B. Explanation:** "the rest of the dead" (v.5a)
 - 1. Division: "the rest of the dead did not come to life..."
 - 2. Delay: "...until the thousand years were completed"
- **C. Exaltation:** "blessed and holy...the first resurrection" (vv.5b-6)
 - 1. Justified: "blessed"
 - 2. Sanctified: "holy"
 - 3. Glorified: "a part in the first resurrection"
 - a. Power: "over these the second death has no power"
 - b. Priests: "will be priests of God and of Christ"
 - c. Position: "will reign with Christ"
- II. <u>JUDGMENT</u>: "the dead were judged" (vv.11-15)
 - A. Courtroom: "a great white throne" (vv.11-12a)
 - B. Testimony: "books were opened" (vv.12b-13)
 - C. Sentence: "the second death, the lake of fire" (vv.14-15)
