### MAIN IDEA:

God's judgment falls hard on those who \_\_\_\_\_ to their privilege.

### 1. A special privilege (Law & covenant)...

- they held the essence of truth and wisdom (2:17-18)
- recipients of God's covenant

+ "Jew" = 'praised'

- privilege led to arrogance...not humility (2:19-20)

### ...but not living according to that privilege

- they didn't practice what they preached (2:21-23) Mal. 3:8-10
- consequently, God's name is blasphemed Isa. 52:5; Ezk. 36:22
