2. The Requirement of the Gospel

- justification a legal term
 - + justification v. condemnation
 - + a legal declaration, not a moral declaration
 - + based on a double transfer Deut. 25:1; Prov. 17:15; Ex. 23:7; Rom. 4:5
- redemption a commercial term
 - + bought back/delivered from a bondage Ex. 15:13; Isa. 43:1
 - + bought at the price of Christ's blood Eph. 1:7; 1 Pet. 1:18-19
- **propitiation** a relational term
 - + paganism: assuaging the wrath of the gods
 - + Christianity: God assuaging His wrath upon Himself
 - + place of the OT sacrificial system Heb. 10:4: 9:11-12
