II. Regularly worship the prayer-hearing God (7-8).

"Every morning when he dresses the lamps ... when Aaron sets up the lamps at twilight"

Our fear ⇔ unanswered prayers ⇔ Cynicism.

Pride \rightarrow prayerlessness \rightarrow powerless Humility \rightarrow prayer \rightarrow power
