There are different seasons in life and in the ministry. Since we moved to Quebec City 10 years ago, we've seen God at work in so many ways. We went through ups and downs, but NEVER would we have dreamt of having a season like the one we're in right now. Let me share some amazing news regarding our ministry and our family.

April 1st marks our 10-year anniversary here in Quebec City. When we first arrived, we took a struggling church of about 40 people. Our hope was never to have a big church as Quebec is too hard of a place to minister to have such expectations (Most churches have an attendance of under a hundred). Nevertheless, we invested our lives in shepherding our people and did our best to have an impact in our community by reaching out to them with the Gospel. God led people that were thirsty for the Truth and on fire to reach the lost. As you know, throughout the years we grew in unity and in number. My wildest dreams never prepared me to experience what we've been seeing for the last two years. In short, we have more than doubled in attendance in the last 24 months. There are now about 250 people that call our church their family; in March, we will add 40 new members... How is this even possible? The Grace of God.

With great blessings come great challenges and here are some that we're facing: The place where we meet for our services was already almost full, so imagine the struggle now! The auditorium is maxed out and we have an overflowing room that is also full every Sunday. We do not have the budget to move to a bigger place, but our landlord told us that he would let us rent an additional space to where we are. We have grown our deacon's board from two members to eleven and soon thirteen, but the growth of the pastoral team has not followed as I'm still the only pastor. We have good prospects that should be ready in the next two years, but ... let's say it's an excellent prayer request! One of the main challenges of having such a quick growth has to do with preserving our DNA and staying united. We are so grateful that the Grace of God is more than enough!

On the family side, we also have some very exciting news: Jacob will be marrying his long-time friend on June 3rd. Amélie is an amazing young woman who loves the Lord deeply. Moreover, Anabel will also get married to her long-time friend in September. Steven is the perfect Godly man for my sweet daughter. Even though we are closely knit, we don't feel that we are losing our kids, but rather that we are gaining two more.

We realize that we haven't seen most of you guys in years. That's why we would love to be able to report to your church in person this summer. Our goal would be to share the amazing blessings that we've experienced in the past and also our vision for the future. To be 100% transparent, it seems like we will be staying to our current work and not move on to another church plant. Therefore, we would love to be able to meet with you one last time face to face to celebrate with you our great God for who He is and for what He has done with us through our partnership.

We would like to extend, once again, our sincere gratitude for your spiritual and financial support. We are grateful for your words of encouragement, your gifts, and for everything that you do so we can joyfully minister here. Knowing that you were praying for us was a source of profound blessing during all those years. Thank you!
