

## Mark 11 – When the King Arrives

### 1) The King's Arrival (v. 1-10)

Two primary prophecies fulfilled:

- Zechariah 9:9
- Daniel 9:24-26

Zech 9-10 – Messiah's arrival brings...

- Peace – Zech 9:10
- Prosperity – Zech 9:12, 16-17
- Prominence – Zech 10
- Also, Dan 9:24 – *“make end of sin, make atonement for sin, bring in everlasting righteousness.”*

Zech 11 – an unexpected action

- Zech 11:4-6 – *“I will no longer have pity on the inhabitants of this land...I will deliver none”*
- Also, Dan 9:26 – *the holy city will be destroyed, with its people... there will be war and desolations.*
