040421A INTRODUCTION

- 1. Paul's teaching on the resurrection in <u>1C 15</u>. Jesus' resurrection: bodily.
 - i. $\underline{v35}$ = the question being answered
 - ii. Not *flesh* [Jn 1:14] but *body*: entire humanity, all faculties.
- 2. Resurrection is not of some aspect of our humanity, but of *body* <u>v42a</u> lit: "out of the dead ones" "standing up in the midst of corpses" [Ezek 37]

1st: Your Body Now and Then

- 1. Bible's binary: this age & age to come, not material & immaterial: <u>v44b-49</u>
- 2. Now & then: this age & age to come [Mt 12:32; Lk 18:30; Eph 1:20-21]
- 3. This age: bounded by creation & 2nd coming & pivots into age to come in resurrection, Final Judgment -> eternal state.
- 4. Humans live in 2 ages natural then spiritual body. Our humanity as image v49. Note: Paul speaks to Christians.
- **5**. Christ as 2nd Adam [v45] <u>v20-26</u> [Rm 5:17]
 - i. *1st natural man* = Adam creation & sin/death
 - ii. Resurrected Jesus = *last Adam* [*the heavenly 2nd man*] obedience/life & resurrection.
- 6. Our humanity both in Adam [natural/earthy] & Christ [spiritual/heavenly] is embodied. Your body now & then.

2nd: Your Body Before

- 1. The human body before the Fall original creation $\underline{v45a}$ = Gn 2:7
- **02.** God directly *formed* Adam [*the man*] *of dust* made alive by in-breathing [w/ His *nephesh* = *breathe*] & man became *living being* [animals Gn 3:19 creaturely life], but only Adam is image of God, son of God.
- **3**. Would you like to have a body like Adam's pre-Fall, pre-death, body?

3rd: Your Body Now

1. It is impossible to obtain a non-cursed-body. Point of reference is future body - $\underline{v35}$. Our hope is not optimum health but resurrection.

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- 2. <u>v35-38</u> analogy: a seed planted & plant grows. *Sow* = die; *raise* = resurrect.
- **3.** 4 couplets contrast now-body w/ resurrection-body $\underline{v36-38}$
 - i. Perishable & imperishable:
 - ii. dishonor & glory
 - iii. power & weakness
 - IV. Body stands for entirety of humanity not just muscles & organs but also mind & faculties of "soul". [An aside: apply to interp of 2C 4:16]

4th: Your Body Then

- 1. Recall Bible's binary of v44-49. How are we to think of resurrected body?
- 2. <u>v45b</u> think of the resurrected Jesus: *became life-giving spirit*: "life" + "making" used re: resurrection life. <u>v22</u>; <u>v36</u>.
 - i. Jn 5:21; Jn 6:63; Rm 4:17b; Rm 8:11; Eph 2:5
 - ii. What does the resurrected Jesus give us? Life resurrection life.
- 3. The resurrected Jesus is embodied *first fruits* [v20] v23. As is it w/ the first fruits, so it is w/ the entire harvest. All that the incarnate Son of God accomplished, is accomplished bodily. Phil 3:20-21 bodily hope.
- 4. What is Jesus' glorified body like? Transfiguration: Mt 13:43; Dan 12:3

Applic - Be Some Body

- 1. <u>1C 6 :19-20</u> glorify God in your body 1C 10:31
- 2. All involved in living this *natural* life is to be submitted to the power & purpose of our *spiritual* life lived in strength of HS by faith in the risen Jesus. Paul's applic = $\frac{1C \ 15:58}{15:58}$
