Scripture:	John 20:11-23

Introduction: *Shame-filled disciples are ministered to by Jesus!* A. We started without *shame* (Gen. 2:25) but became *ashamed* (Gen. 3:7-8)

B. Shame makes you want to hide (cover) and run (Gen. 3:7-8)

- C. Mary Magdalene knew all about shame (Luke 8:2) 1. Details of her life are sketchy but suggestive
  - 2. But Jesus rescued her by *coming into her life* (Gen. 3:9) a. nothing conquers and delivers more than *unconditional love*
  - 3. No wonder she is weeping and inconsolable (John 20:11-13)
    a. 'forgiven and accepted' does not remove all baggage of past
    - b. for believers personal Easter is future (1 Cor. 15:51-57)

### **The First Message of the Risen Lord** I. Stunning address II. The stunning content

# I. The stunning address of Jesus' first message to His 11 disciples

- A. The address of Jesus' message: *11 deeply ashamed men* (Mark 14:50)1. Did they feel like hiding from Jesus?
  - 2. Did they deserve a sternly rebuking message?
- B. Jesus' message has a stunning address and tone: to go my brethren!1. Jesus did not avoid them but sought them gently and lovingly
  - 2. According to Heb 2:11, He is not ashamed to call them brethren

- C. Beloved believers: *Do you hear what Jesus calls and speaks to* **you**? 1. Brethren, Peace be unto you! (vs. 19)
  - 2. Also this 'truth' requires faith to believe it! (Romans 15:13)

## II. His first message also includes a stunning revelation A. It is not *that God is His and their Father & God*

- B. Stunning is that *He is ascending* 
  - 1. Twice before Jesus has referred to ascending (John 3:13; 6:62)
  - 2. Though they did not yet taste the comfort of it, it is a cause for joy!
- C. Stunning is that He ascending to His and their Father/God

### **Two applications:**

A. Seekers of Jesus: fail not to drink from this cup of Easter comfort

B. Neglecters of Jesus: fail not to note what you miss out on Easter
