- 1. Let's Open Our Bibles:
  - Once Again:
    - To John 10 Where:
      - We Come To A New Scene:
        - In The Life & Ministry Of:
          - Our Lord Jesus Christ!
  - Up Until Now:
    - Jesus Was Dealing With:
      - The Aftermath Of Healing:
        - On The Sabbath:
          - A Man Who Had Been Blind:
            - From Birth!

- 2. And In The First Part:
  - Of Chapter 10:
    - Jesus Takes The Opportunity:
      - To Teach & Explain:
        - Not Only Why:
          - The Blind Man:
            - Did Believe In Him!
        - But Also Why:
          - The Pharisees:
            - Did Not Believe In Him!

- It All Depended On:
  - The Flock They Belonged To:
    - As Sheep!
      - Whether His Or:
        - Another's!
- 3. Well Starting In:
  - 10:22 John Moves On And Tells Us:
    - That "It was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter. / And Jesus walked in the temple in Solomon's porch!"
      - So Several Months Had Passed:
        - Since The Previous Events!
  - And Now Jesus Was In Jerusalem:
    - For A Special Time:
      - Of Commemoration & Celebration:
        - At "The Feast Of The Dedication!"
    - This "Feast" Is Also Known As:
      - "The Feast Of Lights" Because Of:
        - The Prominence Of Candles:
          - In Jewish Homes:
            - During The Festival!
  - Today We Know It As:
    - The Jewish Holiday Of:
      - Hanukkah Which Is Still Celebrated:
        - Every Winter Around The Same Time:
          - That We Celebrate Christmas!
- 4. But Hanukkah Is An 8 Day Celebration:
  - That Is Not Found:
    - In The Old Testament!
      - Instead It Was First Observed:
        - After The Jews Revolted Against A Wicked Greek Emperor:
          - By The Name Of Antiochus Epiphanes!
  - He Committed An:
    - "Abomination Of Desolation" When:

- He Offered A Sacrifice To A False God:
  - In The Jewish Temple:
    - And Sacrificed A Pig:
      - On The Altar Of God!
- This Infuriated The Jews:
  - And Caused Them To Revolt And Then:
    - Restore & Cleanse The Temple:
      - Led By A Man Named:
        - Judas Maccabeas In 164 BC!
  - And His Success Led To:
    - An Independent Jewish Kingdom:
      - That Lasted Until Rome Took Over:
        - About A Hundred Years Later!
- 5. So Hanukkah Was:
  - More Than Just A Religious Holiday!
    - It Was A National Holiday:
      - That Sparked A Spirit Of:
        - Independence & Patriotism:
          - In The Heart Of Every Loyal Jew!
  - And So It Was At This Festival:
    - Jesus "Walked In The Temple In Solomon's Porch!"
      - Which Was A Portico On The East Side Of The Temple Courts:
        - With A Roof & Lined With Columns!
    - It Was A Good Place:
      - To Stay Out Of The Cold, Winter Weather:
        - And Still Enjoy The Festivities!
- 6. But As Cold As It Was Outside:
  - Things Were Going To Get:
    - Even Colder Because Of What Happens Next:
      - In 10:24 "Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly!"
  - Now To Be "The Christ" Means:
    - To Be The Messiah!
      - The "Anointed One" That Was Promised By God:
        - In The Old Testament:
          - To Come & Rescue & Redeem His People!
    - For Most Jews At That Time:
      - This Was More Of A:
        - National & Political:
          - Savior Than:
            - A Spiritual One!

- But It Was Still:
  - A Question That People Had:
    - When They Were Confronted With:
      - The Claims Of Jesus!
- 7. But How Did These Jews:
  - Ask Jesus This Question?
    - What Were Their True Intentions?
      - Well I Think We Can Figure Out:
        - Their Intention:
          - When We Are Told That They:
            - "Came . . . Round About Him!"
    - In Other Words They Literally:
      - Ganged Up On Jesus:
        - And Encircled Him:
          - To Keep Him From:
            - Continuing His Walk In The Temple!

- And So I Believe:
  - The Question They Wanted Answered:

- Was A Question:
  - Of Accusation!
- That Is They Did Not Approach Jesus:
  - In A Humble Way Or Even:
    - In A Hungry Way:
      - For The Truth:
        - About His Claims!
- Instead They Wanted Jesus To:
  - Incriminate Himself:
    - In As Clear A Way As Possible:
      - With Plenty Of Witnesses!
  - So That They Would Have No Problem:
    - Accusing Him Of Something:
      - That Would Result In His Death!
- Already In John:
  - We Have Seen How The Jewish Leaders:
    - Wanted To Kill Jesus!
      - Just Because They Were:
        - Jealous Of Jesus!
  - And After This Exchange:
    - They Will Try To:
      - Once Again!
- 8. But How Does Jesus Respond:
  - To Their Questioning?
    - Starting In 10:25 We Are Told:
      - "Jesus Answered Them!"
  - Now All Throughout This Gospel:
    - When Jesus Answers A Question:
      - From The Jews:
        - He Hardly Ever Does So:
          - On Their Terms!
    - So Instead Of Giving Them:
      - The Answer They *Want*:
        - Jesus Gives Them:
          - The Answer They Need!
  - And This Is What Jesus Does:
    - In This Case As Well!
      - So Even Though The Question:
        - The Jews Asked Jesus Was:
          - A Question Of Accusation!
      - The Answer That:
        - Jesus Gives The Jews Is:
          - An Answer Of Great Assurance:
            - For Those Who Believe In Him & Follow Him!

- And So:
  - 10:25-30 "Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me. / But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you. / My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: / And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. / My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. / I and my Father are one!"
- 9. In These Verses:
  - Jesus *Does* Answer Their Question:
    - Plainly Even Though:
      - He May Not Do So:
        - As Directly As:
          - The Jewish Leaders:
            - Wanted Him Too!
  - But For Those Who Have Been Given:
    - Ears To Hear:

- He Gives Even More Proof:
  - That He Is The Christ! And:
    - That All His Claims Are True!
- And In The Verses We Just Read:
  - Jesus Offers 4 Proofs:
    - That He Is The Christ!
  - And That He Came:
    - To Save His People:
      - Not As The Savior Of The Jews, In A National Or Political Sense!
        - But As The Savior Of The World From Sin!
- And As We Go Through These 4 Proofs:
  - Remember That Jesus Is:
    - Worthy Of Your Faith And:
      - Worthy To Be Followed!
        - Because He Is The Christ!
  - And The First Thing Jesus Tells Us:
    - In His Answer To The Jews In 10:25 Is That:

## 1. His Power Is Proof:

- That He Is The Christ!
  - The Power Of His Words And:
  - The Power Of His Works:
    - Is Plain & Clear Proof:
      - That Is The Christ!
- When Jesus Says In 10:25:
  - "I Told You!"
    - He Appeals To The Power:
      - Of His Words!
  - Now Even Though Jesus Made Himself Known:
    - Directly As The Christ:
      - To Some In Private:
        - Like To Andrew (1) & The Samaritan Woman (4) & The Man Born Blind (9)!
    - He Had Not Yet Done So:
      - In Public!
  - But There Are More Ways:
    - To Reveal This Truth:
      - Than In Just A Direct Way!
    - After All He Already Described Himself As:
      - The Bread Of Life!
      - The Son Of God!
      - The Light Of The World!
      - The Door! And:
      - The Good Shepherd!
    - All Starting With The Words:
      - "I Am!" Which Was A Reference:
        - To God Himself!
  - But If The Jews Had Just Known Their Scriptures:
    - All Of These Statements Combined:
      - Would Have Made His Identity Very Clear! Even If:
        - He Didn't Use The Title:
          - Of Christ!
  - Scriptures Like Ezekiel 34:23:
    - Which Pointed To The Messiah As:
      - The Shepherd Promised By God!
        - "And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd!"
  - But How Did The Jews Here:
    - Respond To Jesus' Words?
      - "And Ye Believed Not!"

        - Because - The Power Of Both:
                 - Jesus' Words & Works:
                         - Is Proof That:
                                  - He Was & Is The Christ!
                         - Because - 10:25:
                                  - "They Bear Witness Of Me!"
                 - And This Is Proof That:
                         - Jesus Is Worthy Of Your Faith - And:
                                  - Worthy To Be Followed!
                                           - His Power Is The Proof!

- Even The Promised Shepherd!
- And His People Are Further Proof:
  - That He Is The Christ:
    - Because They Recognize Him:
      - As The Christ!
  - But Where Does This Recognition Come From?
    - Remember When Jesus Asked His Disciples In Matthew 16:15-17:
      - "Whom say ye that I am?"
    - How Did Peter Answer?
      - "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God!"
    - "And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven!"
  - This Recognition Of Jesus:
    - As The Christ:
      - Comes From Heaven Above!
    - But Then Jesus Adds That:
- Only Christ's Sheep:
  - Are Received By Him!
    - Even As A Shepherd:
      - Knows & Receives His Sheep!
    - Again 10:20 Jesus Says:
      - "And I Know Them!"
  - And This Knowledge Is:
    - Like The Knowledge That Exists Between God The Father & His Son! As Jesus Described In:
      - 10:14-15 "I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine. / As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep!"
  - What An Amazing Statement!
    - Jesus Knows Us!
      - In The Same Way That:
        - God Knows Us!
      - Even As We Are Told In 2 Timothy 2:19:
        - "The foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his!"
  - And This Knowledge & Reception:
    - Of God's People:
      - Is Further Proof That:
        - Jesus Is The Christ, The Son Of The Living God!
    - But Then Jesus Adds That:
- Only Christ's Sheep:
  - Will Rely On Him!
    - Even As Sheep Rely On:
      - Their Shepherd!
  - 10:27 "And They Follow Me!"
    - So Wherever Jesus Leads His Sheep:
      - They Will Follow!
- And All Of This:
  - Is Further Proof That:
    - Jesus Is Worthy Of Your Faith And:
      - Worthy To Be Followed!
  - Because Jesus Is The Christ!
    - And The Relationship That:
      - Jesus Has With His People:
        - Is Like No Other!
  - There Are Many Religions:
    - In This World:
      - That Are Only One Sided!
    - The Sheep Hear & Follow:
      - A False Shepherd Or A False God:
    - But Are They Known:

- By Him?
  - In The Same Intimate & Interested Way That We Are Known By Jesus?
- No! And So:
  - The Power Of Jesus And Even:
  - The People Of Jesus:
    - Are Proof That Jesus:
      - The Christ!
    - The One Sent By God:
      - To Be The Savior Of The World!
- \* But Third We Can Also See That:
- 3. Jesus' Provision Is Proof:
  - That He Is The Christ!
    - Even The Provision That Jesus Offers:
      - His People / His Sheep:
        - In 10:28-29 "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. / My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand!"
          - What Powerful & Comforting Words These Are!
    - Because Christ Is The Only One:
      - Who Can Provide:
        - "Life" For Us!
          - And This Life Is:
  - An Immortal Life!
    - IE: A Shepherd Can Sustain Life For The Flock In This World! But Only The True Messiah Can Supply Life Even Eternal Life!
      - Which Is A Life That:
        - Death Can't Even Get In The Way Of!
    - And The Life:
      - That Jesus Gives:
        - Is His Own Life!
    - In Other Words Jesus Gave His Life:
      - For Us When He Died:
        - So That He Could Give His Life:
          - To Us Eternally!
    - And So The Provision:
      - Of Eternal Life:
        - Is Not Only An Immortal Life:
          - It Is Also:
  - An Incorruptible Life!
    - 10:28 "And They Shall Never Perish!"
      - This Means That:
        - The Life Jesus Came To Provide:
          - Is A Life That Will Have None Of The Taint Of Sin!
      - Because Today:
        - Sin Consumes Us:
          - Even As We Live!
    - But One Day:
      - For Those Who Believe & In Belong To Jesus:
        - All The Curse & Corruption Of Sin:
          - Will Be Gone Forever!
    - "The Teaching Of This Verse Is Not That Believers Will Be Saved From All Earthly Disaster, But That They Will Be Saved, No Matter What Earthly Disaster May Befall!" (Leon Morris)
      - And This Means That:
        - This "Eternal Life" That Only Jesus Can Provide Is Also:
  - An Immovable Life!
    - Because 10:28:
      - "Neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand!"
    - Here, Jesus Gives Us Another Picture:

  - So Even Though:
    - Jesus Did Not Answer Their Question:
      - Directly He Answered It:
        - Plainly Enough!
- 2. He Claimed To Be The Christ!
  - And The Jews Considered It To Be:
    - Blasphemy!
      - But Was It?
  - If There Was To Be:
    - A Messiah At All:
      - Would The Not Even Consider:
        - The Proof Of His Claims?
- 3. Because The Proof:
  - That Jesus Gives:
    - In Just These Verses Alone:
      - Is Irrefutable Evidence:
        - That He Is The One:
          - Promised To Be:
            - The Savior & Redeemer Of The World!

- 4. So Remember That:
  - Jesus' Power Is Proof:
    - That He Is The Christ!
  - Jesus' People Are Proof:
    - That He Is The Christ!
  - Jesus' Provision Is Proof:
    - That He Is The Christ! And:
  - Jesus' Person Is Proof:
    - That He Is The Christ!
- 5. And What The Jews Wanted To Use:
  - To Accuse Jesus Jesus Uses:
    - To Assure Us Even More:
      - That He Is The Christ!
  - So Say To The Lord With Confidence:
    - What Peter Said:
      - "Thou Art The Christ, The Son Of The Living God!"
  - Jesus Is Worthy Of:
    - Your Faith And:
      - He Is Worthy To Be Followed!
        - Even Unto Death!
      - Because Not Even Death:
        - Can Get In The Way Of:
          - His Life!
