## Servant-Humility John 13:1-17

## Main Point:

Since Jesus' servant-humility should make a profound difference in how you live, be a humble servant like your Savior.

1. Jesus is the eternally exalted Son of God.

2. Yet, Jesus humbled Himself to the place of a servant for you.

3. Jesus' servant-humility should make a profound difference in how you live.

4. Therefore, be a humble servant like your Savior.

**John 1:1** <sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (NKJV)

**John 1:14** <sup>14</sup> ... the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. (NKJV)

**Philippians 2:5-8** <sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, <sup>7</sup> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross. (NKJV)

**R.C. Sproul** "The true follower of Christ does not grab for glory; he humbles himself as a servant."

**Matthew 23:12** <sup>12</sup> "And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted. (NKJV)

**Matthew 20:25-28** <sup>25</sup> ... "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. <sup>26</sup> "Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. <sup>27</sup> "And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave-- <sup>28</sup> "just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many." (NKJV)
