  - B) God does <u>Test</u> people, but never tempts them.

    - 1) We are tempted in <u>mind</u>, <u>feelings/emotions</u> & will. James 1:14-15
      - (a) Drawn away <u>Lured</u>
      - (b) Enticed Deceitful representations
      - (c) Conceived Act of <u>will</u>
    - 2) We try to **<u>blame</u>** others
  - B) External-Satan & World. John 8:44; 1 Pet. 5:8; 2 Cor. 4:4; 2 Cor. 11:14-15; Matt. 4:1-11
    - 1) Satan's Formula (1 John 2:15-17)
    - 2) Used on Eve, <u>Jesus</u> & us
