# Study 4: Revelation 2:8-11 SMYRNA

## A. The Characteristics of the City: The secular state

## Smyrna was:

- 1. An ancient city one of the oldest in the world.
- 2. A beautiful city one of the most lovely in the world.
- 3. A vain city claimed to be the 'First City'.
- 4. A pagan city the centre of Caesar worship.
- 5. A city with many Jews (see verse 9).

# B. The Condition of the Church: The spiritual state

- 1. The DESCRIPTION of the Speaker
- 2:8. See 1:17-18
- > "The First and the Last..." (Smyrna claimed to be the 'First City')
- > "...who was dead and is alive..." No cancellation of suffering, but consolation in it.

#### 2. The REVELATION

2:9

> "I know..." used tenderly.

#### 3 The COMMENDATION

2.9

- > Because of three things that He knows about their works.
  - i. Your tribulation. The pressure of persecution.
  - ii. Your poverty. Extreme poverty (yet they are rich!)
  - iii. The blasphemy, slander, reviling.

Compare this with the experience of the Lord Jesus Christ. HE says to them "I KNOW..."

- 4 The CONDEMNATION
- > None expressed! No complaints. Satisfied.
- 5. The CAUTION
- 2:10
- > Suffering, Prison, Persecution, Death.
- > An injunction to endure. "Fear not ... be faithful!"

# 6. The EXPECTATION of reward for the 'Overcomer' 2:10-11

- > Do not be afraid of losing your life, for I will give you THE Crown of Life!
- > The Overcomer will not be hurt by the second death.

That is, the eternal, spiritual death which is final separation from God.
