"He Knoweth Our Frame" John 2:18-25

Introduction:

- 1. Let's Turn In Our Bibles This Morning:
 - Back To John 2:
 - Where After Our Lord Jesus
 - Performed His First Miracle:
 - In The Small Town Of Cana Of Galilee:
 - He And His Small Band Of Disciples:
 - Headed To The Big City Of Jerusalem:
 - For The Passover Feast!
 - Where He Fully Commenced:
 - His Public Ministry!
 - And The First Act He Did:
 - Was To Cleanse His Father's House The Jewish Temple:
 - Of All Those Who Had Made It Into:
 - A "House Of Merchandise!"
 - Instead Of Maintaining Its Use:
 - As A "House Of Prayer For All People!" (Isaiah 56:7)
 - And As His Disciples:
 - Witnessed What Was Unfolding Before Their Eyes:
 - John Tells Us In 2:17 That:
 - "His disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up!"
 - And They Were Impressed!
- 2. But Not Everyone At The Temple That Day:
 - Was Impressed!
 - There Were Some Jews There Who Likely Held:
 - Some Position Of Authority:
 - And Had Some Vested Interest:
 - In The Buying & Selling Going On There!
 - And They Were Horrified!
 - Who Did This Man Think He Was:
 - To Do This?
 - And So In The Verses We Come To Next:
 - John Records Their Response!
 - So Let's Read Together:
 - 2:18-25 "Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things? / Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up. / Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days? / But he spake of the temple of his body. / When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said. / Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast [day], many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did. / But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all [men], / And needed not that any should testify of man: for he knew what was in man!"
- 3. Already At The Onset Of Jesus' Public Ministry:
 - Not Only Do We Find:
 - A Reference To Jesus' Death And Resurrection:
 - We Also Find The Kinds Of People:
 - Jesus Will Face:
 - All Throughout His Days On This Earth!
 - And Even To This Day!
 - We Find Three Different Groups Of People:
 - Represented Each:
 - With A Different Kind Of Faith!
 - There Were Those:
 - With No Faith!
 - Who Questioned Jesus' Authority To Do What He Did In The Temple!
 - There Were Those:

- With Nominal Faith:
 - Who Believed In Jesus, But Only Because Of The Miracles he Did! And:
- There Were Those:
 - With Nurtured Faith:
 - Who Not Only Believed In Jesus, But Followed Jesus From Their Heart!
- And Jesus In His Wisdom:
 - Treated Each Group:
 - Differently According To Their Faith And:
 - Their Reception Of Him!
- 4. And Jesus Could Do This:
 - Because Jesus Knew The Hearts:
 - Of Every Single Person:
 - He Came Into Contact With!
 - At The End Of These Verses:
 - In 2:24b-25 John Tells Us That:
 - "He Knew All Men! And Needed Not That Any Should Testify Of Man: For He Knew What Was In Man!"
 - What A Remarkable Statement!
 - And What A Significant Claim!
 - In Addition To:
 - All Of The Other Claims Already Made:
 - About Jesus Here Is Another One:
 - About The Knowledge Of Jesus!
 - "He Knew All Men!"
 - Not Like You Might Know Someone!
 - Based On What They Say & What They Do! Based On External Things!
 - Jesus "Knew" And "Knows" All Men:
 - Based On Who They Are!
 - "For He Knew What Was In Man!"
 - Remember Back In 1 Samuel 16:7:
 - When The Prophet Samuel Was Sent On A Mission To Select Who Would Be The Next King Of Israel?
 - When Samuel Was Impressed:
 - By The Stature And Strength Of The Oldest Of Jesse's Sons!
 - The Lord Told Him "Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for [the LORD seeth] not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart!"
- 5. So Here John Is Making A Further Claim:
 - That Jesus Was Omniscient!
 - Jesus Was All-Knowing In His Divine Nature!
 - And Thus, He Was Able To Peer Into The Deepest & Darkest Recesses Of Our Hearts!
 - And Then Jesus Would:
 - Deal With Men As He Saw Alone Could See Them!
- * And The First Group Of Men He Saw Were Men:
- 1. Of No Faith!
 - This Was The Group Of Jews:
 - That We First Meet In 2:18 Who:
 - When Jesus Cleansed The Temple:
 - Immediately Started Questioning Him!
 - "Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things?"
 - Though They Witnessed His Activity:
 - They Questioned His Authority!
 - Perhaps These Jews Sensed Some Messianic Overtones In What Jesus Had Just Done!
 - Some Believe The Prophecy Of Malachi 3:1-3 Was Fulfilled By Jesus:
 - When He Came Suddenly Into His Temple & Appeared As "A Refiner's Fire & Like Fuller's Soup!"
 - If These Jews Had This Prophecy In Mind:

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- They Wanted To Know The Basis Of His Actions:
                         - And So - They Asked Him / Demanded From Him:
                                  - "A Sign!"
                 - And - They Would Not Believe:
                         - Without A Sign! Also:
- Though They Witnessed His Ability:
        - They Further Questioned His Approval!
                 - When Jesus Cleared Out The Temple:
                         - With Just His Words And A "Scourge Of Small Chords!" (2:15)
                                  - He Had Done Something That Noone Else Could Have Done!
                 - There Was A Moral Strength & Courage:
                         - In Jesus - That Caused Everyone Who Was In The Wrong:
                                  - To Scatter!
        - But - Instead Of Acknowledging The Legitimacy:
                 - Of Jesus' Actions - Actions:
                         - They Should Have Been Doing Themselves!
                 - They Wanted To Know:
                         - Who Approved Of What He Had Done?
                                  - They Certainly Hadn't!
                                          - And - If God Had - He Could Give Them A Sign!
        - Again - They Would Not Believe:
                 - Without A Sign! Also:
- Though They Witnessed His Ambition:
        - And "Zeal" For His Father's House!
                 - They Further Ouestioned His Association:
                         - With God Himself!
        - Who Did This Man Think He Was?
                 - To Call This Temple:
                         - His Own "Father's House!"
        - So - They Would Not Believe:
                 - In His Authority / Approval / Association:
                         - With God - Without A Sign!
                                  - Later - Jesus Would Address This In John 4:48 - Where He Says:
                                          - "Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe!"
- Well - Remember - Jesus "Knew All Men!"
        - And - Jesus "Knew What Was In Man!"
                 - Jesus Knew That These Men:
                         - Had No Faith! And So:
                                  - He Dealt With Them:
                                          - According To Their Hearts!
        - Instead Of Immediately Complying:
                 - With Their Wish - He Challenges Their Lack Of Faith:
                         - With A Sign! A Sign Of:
                                  - His Own Death & Resurrection!
        - He Told Them:
                 - 2:19 - "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up!"
                         - Now - Everyone There - But Jesus:
                                  - Thought He Was Talking About The Physical Temple Standing Right There!
                                          - Even His Own Disciples Thought This!
        - But - Even Though:
                 - In 2:21 - John Gives Us A "Spoiler!"
                         - That - "He Spake Of The Temple Of His Body!"
                                  - At This Point - Noone But Jesus:
                                          - Thought Of Jesus When He Said This!
        - But - He Posed This As A Challenge:
                 - To Their Faith!
                         - If They Wanted A Sign So Badly:
                                  - They Would Have To Act Upon It! And Even "Destroy This Temple!"
                                  (Imperative)
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- Jesus Gave Them A Sign!
 - But They Didn't Really Want A Sign!
 - Because They Were In No Way Willing To Test / Try His Suggestion!
- They Had No Faith:
 - In The Authenticity:
 - Of The Sign Jesus Had Just Shown To Them! And So They Questioned Him:
 - 2:20 "Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt *thou* rear it up in three days?"
 - Will You Do This? Could You Do This?
 - They Believed The Answer Was:
 - No! And So Jesus:
 - Gave Them No More Signs!
- Is This The Kind Of Heart:
 - You Possess? Even With:
 - A Stubborn Faith That Will Not Believe:
 - "Except Ye Signs And Wonders?"
 - There Are Many Like This Even Today!
 - The Lord Jesus Has Already:
 - Given Us Many "Signs And Wonders!"
 - And They Are Recorded For Us:
 - In His Word By Eyewitnesses!
 - If You Find Your Heart To Be Hard:
 - Like These Men Of No Faith:
 - Repent From That Hardness:
 - And Turn To Jesus Who Fulfilled This Very Sign:
 - In His Own Temple! His Body! But:
- * Also In These Verses We Find Another Group Of Men Who Were Men:
- 2. Of Nominal Faith!
 - This Is The Group Of Jews:
 - We Find In 2:23 Who Saw Jesus:
 - Perform Miracles On The Day Of The Passover Feast!
 - "Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast [day], many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did!"
 - Now This Is A Remarkable Verse:
 - Because We Are Told That:
 - "Many Believed In His Name!"
 - Not Just A Few But Many!
 - And We Are Told That They Believed:
 - In The Way That John Himself:
 - Wants His Readers To Believe!
 - 20:31 "But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name!"
 - And What Happens To Those Who Do Believe?
 - In 1:12 "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, [even] to them that believe on his name!"
 - So At First It Appears That This Group:
 - Has A Genuine Faith In Jesus!
 - They Believed In & Trusted In:
 - His Name!
 - But In The Very Next Verse:
 - John Tells Us 2:24 "But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all [men]!"
 - There's An Interesting Play On Words Here!
 - "Commit" Is The Same Word As "Believe" In 2:23!
 - As If John Is Saying Even Though Many Believed In Jesus, Jesus Could Not Believe In Them! Even Though Many Trusted In Jesus, Jesus Could Not Entrust Himself To Them!
 - What Does This Mean?

- Once Again Jesus Knew The Hearts:
 - Of These Men And That Their Faith In Him:
 - Was A Weak Faith Or A Shallow Faith At Best!
- After All What Was Their Faith In Him:
 - Based On? Primarily:
 - John Tells Us "When They Saw The Miracles Which He Did!"
- So Once Again:
 - In His Great Wisdom:
 - Jesus Checked Their Faith:
 - I Believe Out Of Compassion And Grace To Them!
- You See If Jesus Had Entrusted & Committed Himself:
 - To Them In All Of His Capacity:
 - As The Messiah:
 - It Might Have Caused Their Weakened Faith:
 - To Fail & To Fall!
 - **IE:** Like A Baby You Don't Give Meat To Eat At First But Mother's Milk! Otherwise, They Could Choke And Die!
 - Jesus Knew That They Needed:
 - More So That Their Faith Would Increase!
- He Knew That There Needed To Be:
- More Truth:
 - Upon Which Their Faith Could Rest!
 - It's Not Sign's & Miracles That Increase Faith!
 - Its God's Word!
 - Romans 10:17 "So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God!"
 - He Knew They Also Needed:
- More Testing:
 - The Soil Of Their Hearts Was Very Much Like:
 - The Stony Ground In Jesus' Parable Of The Sower:
 - Mark 4:16-17 "Who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; / And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended!"
 - Though The Roots Of Their Faith:
 - Were Shallow Through The Tender Care Of Christ:
 - Their Hearts Could Be Cultivated And Transformed Into Good Soil:
 - For Those Roots To Go Deep!
 - He Knew They Also Needed:
- More Training:
 - And That Is Why:
 - Jesus Did Not "Commit" Himself To Them:
 - Right Then & Right There!
 - Instead He Continued His Ministry:
 - For Three Years So That Over Time:
 - Their Faith In Him Could Grow:
 - Deeper & Stronger & Wider & Greener!
- Perhaps This Is The Kind Of Heart:
 - You Possess! Even:
 - A Shallow Faith That Though Real:
 - Is Still Very Weak!
 - Remember That The Lord:
 - "Knows All Men" Including You & Your Heart!
 - And Psalm 103:14 "He Knoweth Our Frame; He Remembereth That We Are Dust!"
 - Even As Christ Is Patient With Us:
 - You Need To Be Patient:
 - With The Work He Is Doing In Your Heart & In Your Life!
 - Though He Has Committed Himself To You:
 - By Living / Dying / Rising Again For You:
 - You Still Have So Much More Room To Grow In Your Faith!

- And He Continues To Teach You & Test You & Train You:
 - Through Your Whole Life Long!
 - Isaiah 28:10 "For precept [must be] upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, [and] there a little!"
- Don't Just Believe In Jesus!
 - Follow Him!
 - Because "If Thou Faint In The Day Of Adversity, Thy Strength And Thy Faith Is Small!" (Proverbs 24:10)
- * But Then We Come To The Third Group Of Men Who Were Men:
- 3. Of Nurtured Faith!
 - This Group Is The Disciples Of Jesus:
 - Who Had Already Followed Jesus:
 - From The Jordan River To Cana To Capernaum:
 - And Now To Jerusalem!
 - And Jesus Had Already:
 - Committed & Entrusted To Them:
 - More Than He Had To Any Other!
 - Because Once Again 2:25 "He Knew What Was In Man!"
 - And When Jesus Said 2:19 "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up!"
 - It Was This Group Of Men:
 - Who Learned That 2:21 "He spake of the temple of his body!"
 - How Did They Come To Understand This?
 - 2:22 "When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said!"
 - It Wasn't Until:
 - Three Years Later At The *End* Of Jesus Minstry:
 - That These Disciples Learned:
 - What Jesus Meant When He Said These Words:
 - At The *Beginning* Of His Ministry!
 - And This Shows The Kind Of Faith:
 - That Was In Their Hearts!
 - Not Completely Stubborn:
 - As Those With No Faith!
 - Not As Shallow:
 - As Those With Nominal Faith!
 - But Strong & Growing:
 - Because It Was Based On:
 - Not Just The Works Of Jesus, But His Words!
 - And So With This Kind Of Faith:
 - There Was:
 - A Commitment To Teachability!
 - They May Not Have Understood:
 - What Jesus Meant Then:
 - But They Were Open To The Lord's Teaching:
 - Whenever It Would Come!
 - And In 2:22 It Came When:
 - "They Remembered!"
 - In The Passive Tense Which Means:
 - They Were "Reminded!"
 - Who Could Have:
 - Jogged Their Memory:
 - About These Things?
 - God Himself, Through His Spirit!
 - And They Were Humble & Open & Teachable:
 - To The Lord To Clarify:
 - Their Misunderstandings!
 - And That's Because They Also Had:
 - A Commitment To Truth!

- Especially To In 2:22: - "The Scripture" And "The Word Which Jesus Had Said!" - Essentially - Equating The Two! - Jesus' Words Were God's Word! - And God's Word: - Is Truth! - They Learned: - From The Completion Of This Sign: - That All That Jesus Said: - Was & Is So! - In A World: - Where Truth Has Become Relative: - Those With A Faith-Filled Heart: - Will Be More & More Committed To The Truth: - Of God's Word! - But - There Will Also Be: - Jesus' Disciples Didn't Just: - Listen To Jesus: - To Satisfy Their Curiosity! - They Listened To Believe!
- A Commitment To Trust!
 - 2:22 "When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said!"
 - When You Truly Believe In:
 - The Words *Of* Jesus:
 - Like These Disciples:
 - You Will Believe In:
 - The Words About Jesus!
 - So Often The Reason Why:
 - People Don't Believe In:
 - The Truth Of The Old Testament:
 - Is Because They Really Don't Believe In:
 - The Truth Of The New Testament And:
 - Jesus' Words!
 - But They Are All Truth!
 - And Require Our Trust!
- Is This The Kind Of Heart:
 - You Possess! Even With:
 - A Strong Faith That Rests:
 - Completely Upon The Word Of God:
 - And The Work Of Christ!
 - This Kind Of Heart:
 - Is Like The Good Soil:
 - In Jesus' Parable Of The Sower & The Seed!
 - Mark 4:20 "And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive [it], and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred!"
 - Jesus Commends:
 - This Kind Of Heart & This Kind Of Faith!
 - Are You Teachable?
 - Are You Committed To The Truth?
 - Are You Willing To Trust:
 - That Whatever The Lord Says:
 - Is So? No Matter Who Or What Anyone Else Might Say?
 - Keep Following Christ:
 - In This Way!

Conclusion:

- What Group Would You Have Been In: 1.
 - If You Were At The Temple:

- In Those Days?
 - You Can Tell:
 - By Considering The Soil Of Your Own Heart!
- But Don't Do This On Your Own!
 - Pray & Plea To The Lord:
 - "Search Me, O God, And Know My Heart: Try Me, And Know My Thoughts!"
- 2. Is Your Heart:
 - A Stubborn Heart?
 - Full Of No Faith?
 - Always Questioning:
 - The Word & Work Of The Lord?
 - If So Repent And See That:
 - The Sign Jesus Gave Then:
 - He Actually Fulfilled!
 - To Save You From Your Sinful & Stubborn Heart!
- 3. Is Your Heart:
 - A Shallow Heart?
 - Full Of A Nominal & A Weak Faith?
 - Do "The cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful!" (Mark 4:19)
 - If So Ask Jesus To Help You:
 - Follow Him! And:
 - Commit Yourself To:
 - The Daily Means Of Growth & Grace!
 - His Word, Prayer, Church!
 - If Your Faith Is Weak:
 - Then You Need To Follow The Lord:
 - As Close As You Can!
 - Step By Step!

- 4. Is Your Heart:
 - A Strong Heart?
 - Full Of Faith That Is Willing To Be:
 - Nurtured By The Lord:
 - Through The Word & His Spirit?
 - Then Stay Teachable!
 - Ask The Lord To Keep:
 - "Molding You & Making You After His Will!"
 - After All He Is The Potter:
 - And You Are The Clay!
- 5. Praise The Lord:
 - That He "Knoweth Our Frame!"
 - And He Deals With Us:
 - According To His Knowledge And Wisdom!
 - Let The Lord:
 - Take Your Heart The Way It Is:
 - And Cultivate It So That:
 - Your Faith May Grow:
 - Deeper & Stronger & Wider & Greener!
 - Even Like A Tree:
 - "Planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper!" (Psalm 1:3)
