

Outside the Camp (Hebrews 13:13,14)

- Text speaks so completely against the spirit of the age in the church today
- Church seems so desirous to become palatable & acceptable to the world
- Christianity: a call to die, call to come out of the world not hold on to it
- Last week we considered:

1. We have an altar – Jesus, His finished works
2. Jesus Suffered Outside the Gate or Camp
3. That He Might Sanctify us

I. Go Forth to Him, God Outside the Camp (13:13)

- a. What does it mean to go outside the camp?

Hebrews 11:25,26; 12:2; Ex 33:7

- b. What does it mean to remain inside the camp?

Luke 9:25; 1 John 2:15-17

II. No Continuing City – Seek the One that is to Come (13:14)

- The connection: Go out the camp –here there is no lasting city
- For the Jews, the priesthood & temple would soon be destroyed (AD70)
- Present Jerusalem shaken & moved – our city is unshakeable (12:23,24)
- Earthly Jerusalem – has no more eschatological significance
- Given way to the heavenly Jerusalem – the bride adorned for her husband
