3. How Membership?

- 6. Do you submit to the Biblical oversight and discipline of the elders in your local church?
- 7. Do you affirm all these things, believing the whole Bible to be true and the Word of God?

8. Do you, the members of this congregation promise to love this sister in Christ; and to encourage and pray for her in her Christian walk and witness?
