5 Characteristics of God's Judgment - v. 1-16

- God Judges Finally on the Last Day
- God Judges Simply judges based on what we do.
- God Judges Impartially not comparing people
- God Judges Comprehensively even your "secrets"
- God Judges Mercifully giving you time to repent

Let's bring it close to home, let's translate the terms into how we daily encounter this issue...

<u>Circumcision</u> = Baptism & Communion <u>Jews</u> = Christians <u>Uncircumcised</u> = non-Christian <u>Uncircumcision</u> = never baptized, barred from Table Law = all Bible, but particularly NT writings of Apostles
