

1. Could you explain what the significance is of Moses and Elijah appearing and conversing with Jesus at the transfiguration (Matthew 17, Mark 9, Luke 9)?
2. What does the Bible say about tattoos? Is it sinful?
3. Considering the Triune God, is there a practice of praying to the Holy Spirit or how should the direction of our prayers be understood?
4. Does God respond to the prayers of unbelievers? Is it appropriate for believers to encourage unbelievers to pray about things?
5. David killed Goliath in 1 Samuel 17. Then, 2 Samuel 21 says Elhanan killed Goliath. Was it Goliath's brother that was killed or some relative of the giant?
6. What does the Bible say about cremation versus body burial?
7. When unbelievers endure hardship that you are not a part of, what is the best way to resolve an emotional stress besides just ignoring the problem? What would be your biblical advice?
8. How do we discern between our conscience and the Holy Spirit? How does the Holy Spirit communicate with us?
9. How do the persons of Christ and the Holy Spirit vary in dwelling or filling us?
10. How should Christians think of the concept of "enemies" in light of the Psalms that use battle language or ask for refuge from enemies? How are we to view people or institutions whose hostility and machinations threaten or harm, even if it is not directly motivated by antagonism towards Christ?
11. Acts 15:28-29 seems to be a summation of sanctification for the Gentiles who were being saved. How does this apply to us today?
12. Christians and churches have had criticism for too much or too little focus on community service. What are some considerations for a church in deciding on such involvement?
