Sermon: "Are You Sure I'm The Crazy One?" Resurrection Sunday Sermon 2021

**I Text:**

Old Covenant: *Isaiah 53*

New Covenant: *1 Corinthians 15:1-34*

**II Doctrine:**

The Apostle Paul clearly lays out the historical veracity of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Paul's beautiful summation of why we celebrate the resurrection of our great King is trustworthy. There is greater textual evidence regarding the New Testament than any ancient document. The life of Alexander the Great was written about three hundred years after his death, yet we do not doubt his existence.

If Jesus Christ did not rise from the dead, Christians are blasphemers and we deserve death. It is actually foolish for "sophisticated" Christians to teach Christ did not physically rise from the dead. The supernatural resurrection of Jesus Christ is not a foolish story. Without advocating a false equivalency, in our everyday lives people who were declared clinically dead, come back to life.

All true believers will rise from the dead just like the Lord Jesus Christ. We already have victory, and on the last day we will meet our God and enjoy life everlasting. Complete victory in Christ is when the last enemy death is defeated for those that believe.
