Luke 22:1-6; Matthew 26:1-16

Leadership dynamics include the:

I. Minister - "chief priests"

Good leaders place high value on:

A. Process - "kill him"

- 1.) What kind of process is that to keep the temple holy? It is called "Jesuit Casualty" which is better known as the end justifies the means. There are always two parts to an organization: 1) The Stated Goals = Ends and 2) The Standard Practices or Processes = Means > So which is God concerned about? BOTH.
- God wants to be God not only of our destination but also God of our journey.
- 2.) Notice a second aspect of the Leader as to timing. The religious leaders were in a hurry to get Jesus. They wanted to do it but also understood that timing was crucial. They want Him but not during Passover.
- 3.) A third aspect of Leaders and Process is understanding that Fear comes from a lack of:
- Love must be there or else it will be replaced by fear.
 - o I John 4:18 "Perfect Love casts out all fear"
- Faith -
 - Luke 8:50 "Fear not only believe"
- ➤ Control by the Holy Spirit
 - o II Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us the Spirit of fear, but of power, love and a sound mind.

B. Peace – "feared the people"

- Peace comes as a result of fearing God more than people.
- Peace comes from Trusting God more than trusting people. Philippians 4:6-7

C. Partnerships - "covenanted"

- What a mess we get into when we get unequally yoked. This applies to:
 - o Marriage
 - Intimate friendships
 - o Business Partnerships
 - o Club Membership

II. Multitude -"the people"

Followers have a role in providing:

A. Immunity – "in the absence of the multitude"

Protection thru Our Presence

We are called to follow, yes, but also to:

- 1.) Pray for our Leaders especially when we disagree with them.
- 2.) Check up on our leaders statements
- 3.) Vote, write letters, make calls, emails
- 4.) Be Alert and in Attendance

B. Inspiration – "came unto Him"

Inspiration means to: Stimulation of the mind or emotions to a high level of feeling or activity. $Hebrews\ 13:17 = joy = III\ John\ 4$

III. Menace - "Satan"

The enemy will be found in:

- **A. Hosts** "entered Satan into Judas"
- > Satan desires to use human beings through:
 - o Possessions
 - o Oppression
 - Manipulation
- **B** Hostility "sought opportunity"
- C. Haplessness "spoiled principalities" Col. 2:15

Communication

- Autonomy we must be certain that we allow people freedom to choose. (Being careful not to boss people around)
- Belonging we must be careful not to speak in terms that ostracize the individual or make them feel alone. Embarrassment, generalities, and character assassinations should be eliminated from our communication tactics.
- Competence we must be sure to not discredit or demean someone as though they were a child or unlearned. We should assume that they possibly already know what we are telling them or will quickly understand after we explain it.
