## **B.** Viewing Her Commitment

- 1. Commitments are Binding.
  - a. God holds us to our commitments—Ecclesiastes 5:4-5
  - b. Many today take a light view of commitment
  - c. Hannah could have built a case for commitment under duress.
    - 1) Hannah was wife #2 in a polygamous marriage.
      - a) God's definition of Marriage—Mark 10:6-9
      - b) Polygamy is not God's ideal
      - c) God allowed and regulated polygamy—Deut. 21
      - d) Polygamous relationships full of tension
    - 2) Hannah was childless—1 Samuel 1:2
      - a) Childlessness a "curse" from God—Deut. 7; Ps. 128
      - b) Children a "sign" of God's blessing
    - 3) Hannah caught in a "Love-Hate Triangle"—1 Sam. 1:4-7
      - a) Still #1 wife in husband's mind—loves her
      - b) Other wife hates her and makes her life miserable
    - 4) Hannah's husband does not understand—1 Sam. 1:8
    - 5) Hannah's spiritual leader maligns her—1 Sam. 1:12-18

## 2. Commitment involves Sacrifice.

- a. We want "commitments" that cost us nothing.
- b. Hannah's commitment cost her Samuel, her son!
- e. Her commitment involved a WILLING Sacrifice—Lev. 27:1-8
  - 1) Could have paid CASH and kept the child
  - 2) They willingly CHOSE to lend Samuel to the LORD

- b. Our fundamental commitment—Romans 12:1
