Mark 13:28-37 — "Be On The Alert! Jesus' Coming Is Near!"

"Christ the Master, is coming soon. Opportunity slips away with each passing minute. When he returns, it will be too late to recover lost opportunity. His judgment will occur immediately, and it will result in the final, irreversible disposition of all souls alive at His appearing -both faithful and unfaithful. Now is our only time to prepare. Today is the only opportunity we are guaranteed. All the resources we have belong to our Lord. Our opportunities for sharing the Gospel, our spiritual opportunities, and all temporal blessings come from His gracious hand. If these resources were ours, we could do them as we please. But they are his, committed to us as His stewards, and we will give account at His coming for how we have used them." (MacArthur)

Passion Week overview:

- Mark 13 occurs on Tues Night; on the Mt of Olives.

THESIS — In our text, Jesus provides **TWO significant lessons** that we hear from these words from our Lord.

(1) Your Savior is Coming! (2) You must be Alert!

I. YOUR SAVIOR IS COMING! (28-32)

A. His coming is **NEAR** (28, 29) = undelayed

B. His coming is **CERTAIN** (30-31)= unfailing

v.30 - "This generation" refers to the generation that is alive at the end. Once the beginning of the end times signs occur, the Son of Man will return before *that generation* passes away. Simply, the end will occur within one generation (Darrel Bock).

v.31 -

- 1. **Inspiration** = MY WORDS (come from God himself)
- 2. **Impossibility** = WILL never / shall never
- 3. Indestructibility = shall not PASS AWAY
 - C. His coming (timing) is **UNKNOWN** (32) = unknown

II. YOU MUST BE ALERT! (33-37)

v.35 - the 4 night "watches" of Roman time

the 4 watches:

- 1. evening = 6-9PM
- 2. Midnight = 9PM-12AM
- 3. Rooster crowing (12-3AM)
- 4. morning/ Dawn (3-6AM)

Simple Questions in Response:

- 1. Are you forgiven of your sins?
- 2. Are you serving in your church?
- 3. Are you faithful to your Lord?
- 4. Are you studying your Bible?

SOME IMPLICATIONS (how this affects you):

1. Be **aware** of world events but not **anxiously consumed** with them.

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- 2. All things will pass away, —but invest deeply, attentively and daily into Christ's Words.
- 3. Remember no one knows the exact time of Christ's 2nd coming
- 4. Faithfully do your God-given task, as Christ's slave, in His absence.
- 5. Christ's return is promised, near, triumphant and motivational.

The time for repentance shall be past. Many shall cry, "Lord, Lord, open to us," but find the door of mercy shut forever. After this there will be no change.
