#### INTRODUCTION

- 1. Preach gospel & call all to repentance Lk 24:44f. Interpret Jesus using the OT A1:3. Prevalence of citations & allusions in NT Isaiah. Rm8:33-34a
  - i. <u>Isa 54:17</u> condemned by men, vindicated by God
  - ii. <u>Isa 50:8-9</u> condemn likely vss in Paul's mind in Rm 8:33-34a
- **2.** Disciples reiterate the experience of Jesus Phil 2:5,8b-9a. Isa 50 describes Jesus' experience & Rm 8:33-34a informs our experience as united to Jesus
- 3. <u>Isa 50:4-11</u> = prophetic voice of Jesus [Hb 12:1-3. We are following Jesus.

### 1st: The Grace to Be a Disciple - v4-5

- 1. Jesus was a disciple of Lord/Father; schooled in Scripture. Listens & obeys
- 2. tongue of disciple speaks to sustain the weary one w/a word.
- **3**. Daily devotion: *morning by morning*

## 2nd: The Grace to Suffer as a Disciple - v6-7

- 1. Physical suffering [Mat 26:67; 27:30]: courts of men & humiliation
- 2. BUT GOD helps Me.
- **3.** See His face? *humiliated* but *set like flint*. KJV Lk 9:51. *I am not disgraced, humiliated I know I will not be ashamed*

#### 3rd: Grace to Endure Men's Condemnation Confident in God's Vindication - v8-9

- 1. Awareness of Lord: v4,7,8. *He vindicates* [justifies] *Me.* 
  - i. Jesus is *vindicated* by His resurrection 1Tim 3:16.
  - ii. Our vindication Rm 2:13
- 2. Humble confidence <u>Isa 50:8-9</u> [Rm 8:33-34a].
  - i. The world w/ it's hatred for X & condemnations, will wear out, motheaten

# Applic #1: Trust or Torment? - v10-11

- 1. The Servant addresses us: naturally in *darkness* of sin & death.
- 2. v10 you who fear the Lord called to trust
- **3.** v11 you who try to dispel the darkness of death w/ lights of your own making, face the One you've condemned: you face death of eternal *torment*.
- 4. <u>51:1a</u> seek Ld now while He may yet be found [Isa 55:6]
