Leviticus 19:3 *"Each of you must respect his mother and father."*

Hebrews 12:9 (Mes) *"We respect our own parents for training and not spooling us . . ."*

Proverbs 13:1 (Mes) *"Intelligent children listen to their parents; foolish children do their own thing."*

Proverbs 23:22 (LB) *"Listen to your father's advice and don't despise your mother's experience."*

Proverbs 6:20-23 (TEV) *"Do what your father tells you, and never forget what your mother teaches you. Keep their words with you always, locked in your heart. 1 Timothy 5:2-4 (NLT) *"[In your church] treat the older women as you would your own mother, and treat the younger women as your own sisters. The church should care for any widow who has no one else to care for her. BUT if she has children or grandchildren, their first responsibility is to show godliness at home and repay their parents by taking care of them. This is something that pleases God."*

1 Timothy 5:8 (GW) *"If anyone doesn't take care of his own family, especially his immediate family, he has denied the Christian faith and is worse than an unbeliever."*
