

# Second Precept - Only God is God



#### Ancient Man - Relied on man-god

- Nimrod Prototype of man-god intercessor
- Each cultural ruler filled this "man-god" role
- Nine signs and Passover demonstrated the fallacy of man-god rulers



## No Gods Beyond Me (I AM)

- Many place this as the first precept; however, I follow a minority pattern that combines this with the second precept
- The idea of gods and idols are two sides of the same coin as man uses idols to unify the people under one religion-government (Two are inseparable as religion informs government of right & wrong (Morality))


- This distinguished Old Testament commentary states that Bible reads, "You shall have no gods beyond Me" which better conveys the meaning than, "before me"
- Or, "You should not have god(s) beyond Me"
- Now, He states there are no other gods. Any gods one "makes" are replacements for God; i.e., beyond God

## Infinite God Irreplaceable

- You replace an infinite God with finite god(s) (idols) {representations} because man and Satan are finite
  - Ancient man did not worship the idols as gods but as representations of the various attributes of god(s) they created beyond God (Hindu idols are representations of Vishnu)
  - They exchanged the truth of God for Satan by images representing the attributes they believed Satan has @colored. ICol 20:62, 20, 22: 271:4340

#### An Ancient (Modern) Pattern

- Man defines god(s); thus, he believes he is god
- However, sinful man is slave to Satan @ 66, 10
- Therefore, worship of anything beyond God is worship of Satan (Death)




#### Satan Worship Common to All Men

- Man's fall hinged on man becoming god; but, man's nature mirrored his new father, Satan, enslaving him to Satan & sin
- Temptation of Christ hinged on the God-Man, Jesus, worshiping Satan in exchange for sin, as Adam did 80-4610
  - Destroying hope of salvation (Life) for men
  - Destroying God Who would have violated His nature
  - Destroying all creation as it emanates from God ⊕ □ □

## True Degradation of Idolatry

- God gave this Precept to warn man of spiritual and physical degradation that affects all aspects of life
- Man embraces degradation
- God lets man wallow in sin (no forced conversions)



## Jealous or Zealous God?

- English word jealous carries negative connotation today
- Hebrew word carries the positive connotation of God being zealous for our good due to His holiness (Cross)
  - Negates idea of a jealous God hurting man for false worship (God causes his suffering due to false worship)
  - Instead God warns man of consequences of sin in ways man understands (prophets, calamities, degradation)

# God Warns of Consequences

- Degradation of sin not only affects the practitioner(s) but also legitimizes the sin to the youth so degradation becomes normal (Trend: pop music, movies, casual sex)
- O This pattern can last 3-4 generations; indeed, entire nations can be affected as leaders legitimize sin that last generations becoming cultural practice, enslaving future generations (Christendom, Judaism, Islam, Hinduism)

## Idolatry Prevalent Today

- Idolatry is practiced today in many forms legitimizing degradation, promoting sin as philosophies & religions
  - O Atheistic governments Man is the idol
  - O Democracies Man is the idol
  - O Christendom Man is the idol
  - Judaism Man is the idol
  - O Islam Man is the idol

#### Globalization Legitimizes Global Sin

- The 20th century's move to regionalization prelude to today's globalization
- Various powerful pseudosciences legitimize this (education, psychology)
- Globalization legalizes idolatry with laws & regs



#### Globalization Legitimizes Degradation

- O The U.N.'s Human Rights are interpreted to mean:
  - Physical immorality legitimized as personal expressions
  - All religions legitimized except the Gospel (Divisive)
  - All practices promoting unity of man (idolatry) allowed
  - All dissent labeled as "hate crimes" and illegal (Gospel)
- "General Welfare of Men" used to suppress Salvation

## Idolatry Brings Unity of Sin

- Worship of man as god used to promote unity through idolatry, which God disrupted at the Ziggurat of Babel to disperse man and prevent Gospel suppression
- Globalization seeks to reunite man with Gnosticism as the substrate to bind all the religions back into the religion that will suppress true Salvation as divisive





# Second Precept Teaches Faith

- The Hebrews could not love God or follow His precepts for they, like us, are sin and hate God
- O It is only by faith, from God, that one can: 86.62023-16-11-60
  - O Believes God exists (First Precept)
  - Believes God gives life and frees us from idolatry (1)=5.35-20
- Only through Christ can we shun the idolatry of Satan
