Matthew 12:46-50 – notes on context and proper exegesis

A difficult message to received due to:
Individualism in the world
Idolatry of family in the church

1. Understanding the text

Jesus had natural brothers (Mark 6:3) (so the Roman Catholic teaching on the perpetual virginity of Mary is wrong).

Jesus' family was unbelieving (Mark 3:20-21, John 7:1-5)

Jesus redefines family, which does two things:

- A. Rebukes the default place that natural family holds (Idolatry of family; we are hard-wired to say "yes" to family; We need our minds renewed to consider family as Jesus does)
- B. An encouragement to all disciples that we are Jesus' family!
