

Though "wisdom" and "understanding" and rarely even the additional word "knowledge, occur together throughout the LXX, the addition of "treasures" and "hidden", in close conjunction with these three words, yields a fivefold world combination that is unique in all the OT....The Messiah is now the grandest expression of divine wisdom ""Reale"

Then the mystery was revealed... he gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding; he reveals deep and hidden things;

to those who have **understanding**; he reveals deep and **hidden** things; (Daniel 2:19, 21-22)

For if you should call upon wisdom, utter your voice for understanding, and if...you should s earch for her as treasures, then you will understand... and find the knowledge of God. For the Lord gives wisdom, and from his presence is knowledge and understanding. (Proverbs 2:3-6 LXX)
