2.	: Abide by the State's laws <i>wherever possible</i> as an expression of your acceptance of God's Providence in the exact manifestations of governing authority in your life (1 Pet 2:13-25, Rom 13:1-4; see also Hos 13:11, Jer 27:5-8, 29:7, 1 Sam 16:1, 1 Kgs 12;15, Prov 28:2, Isa 3:4-7)
