**III. The Self-Deceived are Described by What They Did Not Do...**

**A. They did not do the Will of God...**

**1. The will of God sometimes is a reference to God's sovereign control of all things... Ephesians 1:11; Romans 9:19; James 1:18**  
*In this sense all men always do the will of God...*

**2. The Will of God is also used in reference to God's requirements and commands to all men... Matthew 6:10 cf. Mark 3:35; John 7:17...**

**B. The Will of God begins with "obeying the Gospel..." John 6:28**
