 14 And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.
 15 But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves,
 16 Saying, "What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it."
 17 But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.
 18 And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.
 19 But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. (5:29) Obey God - rather than man
 20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. **Testimony of a witness**
 21 So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done. 3:12 not our power
 22 For the man was above forty years old, on whom this miracle of healing was shewed.

The Christians again filled with the Spirit. (Cf. Acts 2. 1-4.)

23 And being let go, they went to their own company, and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said unto them. **PRAISE REPORT**
 24 And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:
 25 Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things?
 26 The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ - anointed
 27 For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, (Kings/Rulers) Heathen

 29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,
 30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. - vs 27
 31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. 4:8,6:3,5,7:55,9:7,10:44,13:52
 State of the church at Jerusalem. (Cf. Acts 2. 42-47.)
 32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.
 33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all. 2:30-31
 34 Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

PRIDE, heart matter
BUT a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, "beautiful"
 2 And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought "a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet."
 3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?
 4 Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why didst thou do it?
 Jealousy (of Barnabas)
 weak in faith (Appearance of trusting)
 hypocrisy - pretense of fraud/perjury
