The Biblical record regarding wine:

- 1) Wine is considered to be a blessing of God for a wise, obedient life. *Deut.* 7:13; 11:14; 33:28; *Prov.* 3:9-10
- 2) Having no wine to drink is considered to be a curse from God. *Deut.* 28:39; *Is.* 16:10; *Jer.* 48:33; *Hos.* 9:2; *Joel* 1:10; *Amos* 5:11; *Micah* 6:15
- 3) Wine was a sacred acceptable offering that was to be given to God. Ex. 29:40; Lev. 23:13; Num. 15:5, 7, 10; 18:12; 28:7, 14; Deut. 18:4; I Sam. 1:24; II Chron. 31:5
- 4) Wine was a medicinal drink prescribed by God to settle a stomach. *I Tim.* 5:23
- 5) Wine was a drink that God provided to gladden a heart. *Judges 9:13; Ps. 104:14-15*
- 6) Wine, in abundance, which features the best wine, will be a blessing from God in the Future Kingdom.

 Jer. 31:12; Joel 2:24-25; Amos 9:14; Matt. 26:29
- 7) Wine was to be enjoyed when worshipping God in His Sanctuary. *Deut. 14:23, 26; Is. 62:9*
- 8) Wine was very appropriate at wedding celebrations. *John 2:1-11*
- 9) Wine was served at many meals with Jesus Christ and He drank it. Jesus Christ drank real wine, the kind that if you drink too much can get you drunk. In fact, there were those who called him a drunkard. Luke 5, 7:33-34
- 10) Wine was the drink Jesus chose to represent His blood. *Matt.* 26:27-29; *Luke* 22:17-18, 20
- 11) Wine was the drink Jesus sanctioned to be used at church in a communion service.
