    - 1. The *final affirmation of the reliability of this book* is that, “\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ have sent My Angel to testify \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_.” (22:16a)**
      - Is this a reliable source and means of this revelation?
      - What do we observe here about the importance of the local church?
      - What are the “these things” we have studied in this book?
    - 2. The *final description of Jesus Christ* is, “I am the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_, the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.” (22:16b)**
      - What does this underscore?
      - What have we learned about Jesus Christ in this book?
    - 3. The *final invitation of salvation for the unsaved* is that, “the Spirit and the bride say, “\_\_\_\_\_!” And let him who hears say, “\_\_\_\_\_!” And let him who thirsts \_\_\_\_\_ . Whoever \_\_\_\_\_, let him \_\_\_\_\_ the water of life \_\_\_\_\_. (22:17)**
      - Why does the Holy Spirit say this?
      - Who is the Bride and why does it say this?
      - Who is him that hears and why does he say this?
      - Who can obtain the water of life?
      - What does the water of life cost and why?
      - What must the sinner do to obtain the water of life?

- To take God's gift of salvation, what must you conclude about the Word of God?
4. **The *final warnings to those who tamper with this book* [and the Word of God] are, "For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: \_\_\_\_\_ to these things, \_\_\_\_\_ will \_\_\_\_\_ to him the \_\_\_\_\_ that are written in this book; and \_\_\_\_\_ from the words of the book of this prophecy, \_\_\_\_\_ shall \_\_\_\_\_ his part from the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_, from the \_\_\_\_\_, and from \_\_\_\_\_ which are written in this book. (22:18-19)**

6. **The *final response in this book* is, " \_\_\_\_\_ . Even so, \_\_\_\_\_!" (22:20b)**
- Is this your heart's desire and prayer?
7. **The *final benediction of this book* encourages us that while we as believers in Christ face trials and suffering while we wait eagerly for the Lord Jesus Christ to come, let's be reminded that, "The \_\_\_\_\_ of our Lord Jesus Christ \_\_\_\_\_ . \_\_\_\_\_." (22:21)**
