PRAYERS OF JESUS WITHOUT DETAILS

Jesus prayed at His baptism by John the Baptist – Luke 3:21

Praying in a secluded place; Left for mtn to pray alone; Often prayed alone in wilderness; Not listed are when He got alone but prayer is not mentioned –Mark 1:35; 6:45 Luke 5:16; 6:12

Thanks/blessings on food He multiplied when feeding 5000 or 4000 – Matt 14:19; 15:36 Mark 6:41; 8:6-7 Luke 9:16 John 6:11; 6:23

Prayer led to the transfiguration – Luke 9:28,29

Prayed before giving the Model Prayer – Luke 11:1

Did He pray blessing children? – Matt 19:13-15 Mark 10:16

Blessed bread, thanks for wine at Lord's Supper – Matt 26:26-27 Mark 14:22-23 Luke 22:17,19 (thanks only)

Blessed bread after road to Emmaus and revealed Himself – Luke 24:30

Perhaps prayed as He blessed the disciples before He ascended – Luke 24:50-51

JESUS' STATEMENTS ABOUT PRAYER (partial?)

Instructions about prayer and the Model Prayer given – Matt 6:5-14 Luke 11:1-13

Tells disciples to ask the Father to send harvesters – Matt 9:38 Luke 10:2

(Fig Tree) Says that through prayer disciples will receive, and to forgive – Matt 21:18-22 Mark 11:24

Tells them to pray their flight will not be in winter or Sabbath – Matt 24:20 Mark 13:18
